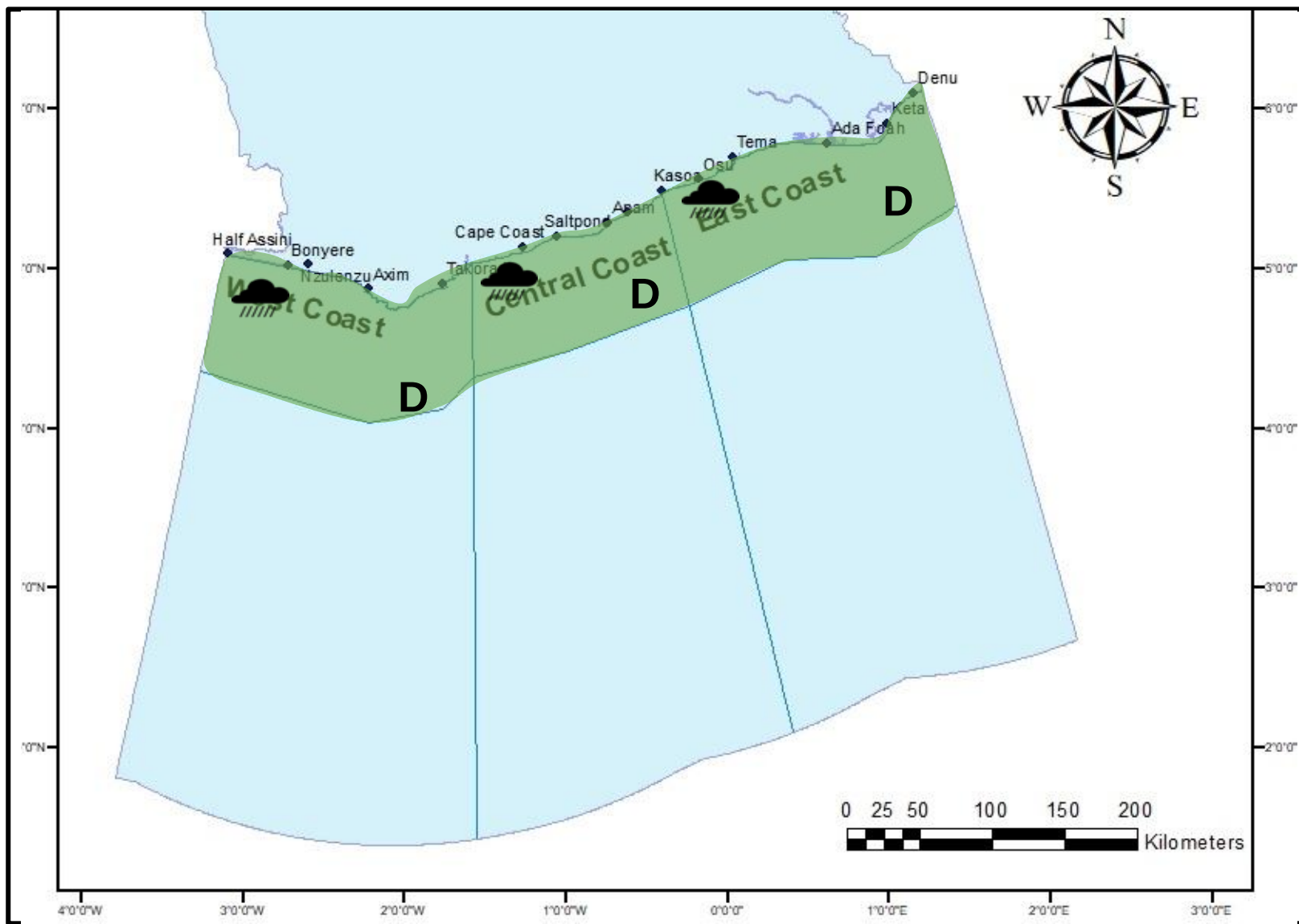

WEATHER SUMMARY: Cloudy weather conditions are expected to dominate the nation's marine space throughout the forecast duration, with brief periods of sunshine over some coastal areas in the afternoon. However, there is a 40-60% likelihood of isolated light to moderate rain over onshore areas between this afternoon and evening hours.

NB: Strong winds are expected over the maritime region during the validity period.
