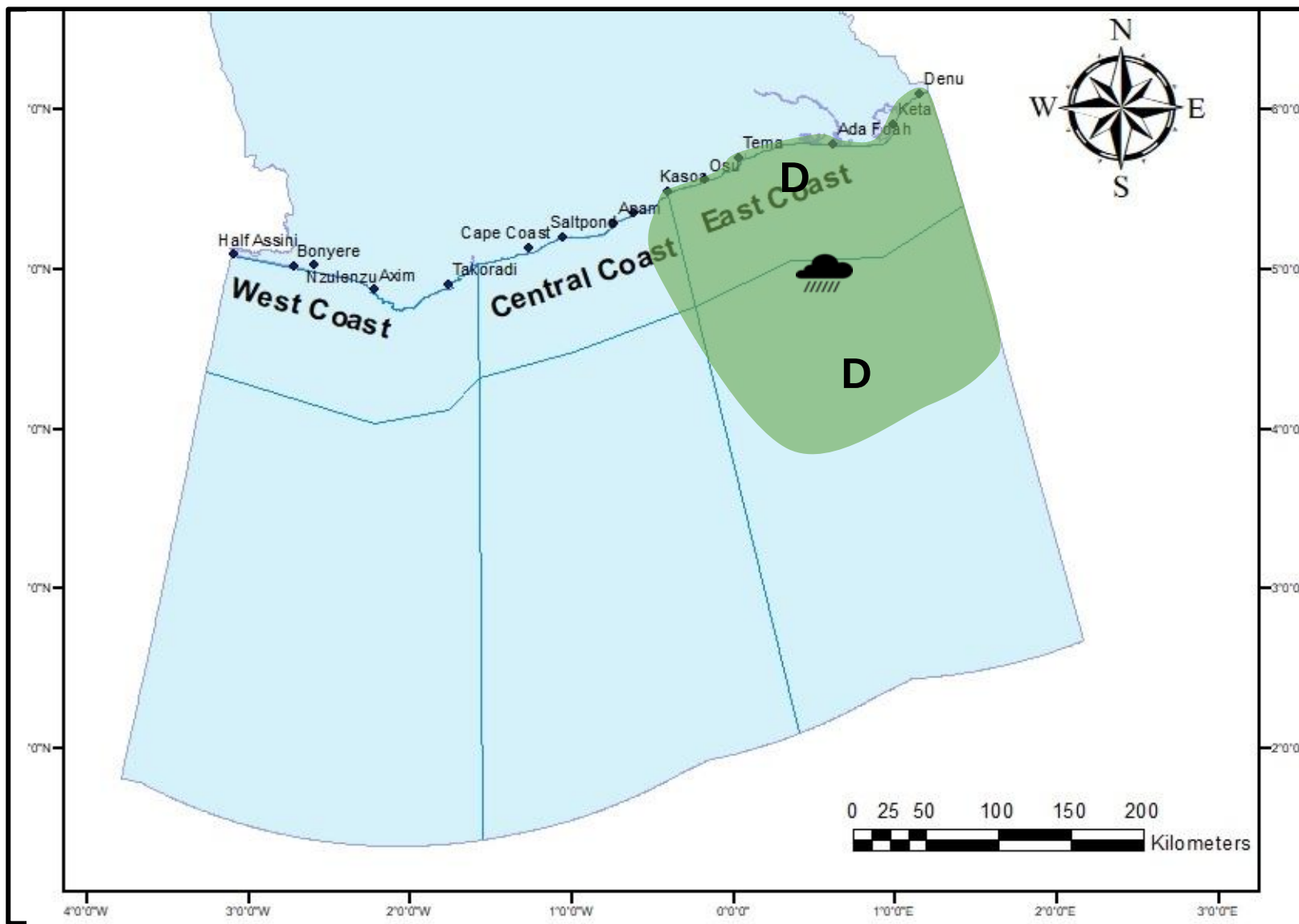

WEATHER SUMMARY: Cloudy conditions are anticipated to prevail across the nation's marine space for the entire duration of the forecast. However, there is a 40% chance of slight, isolated rainfall affecting the eastern onshore areas between the afternoon and evening hours.
