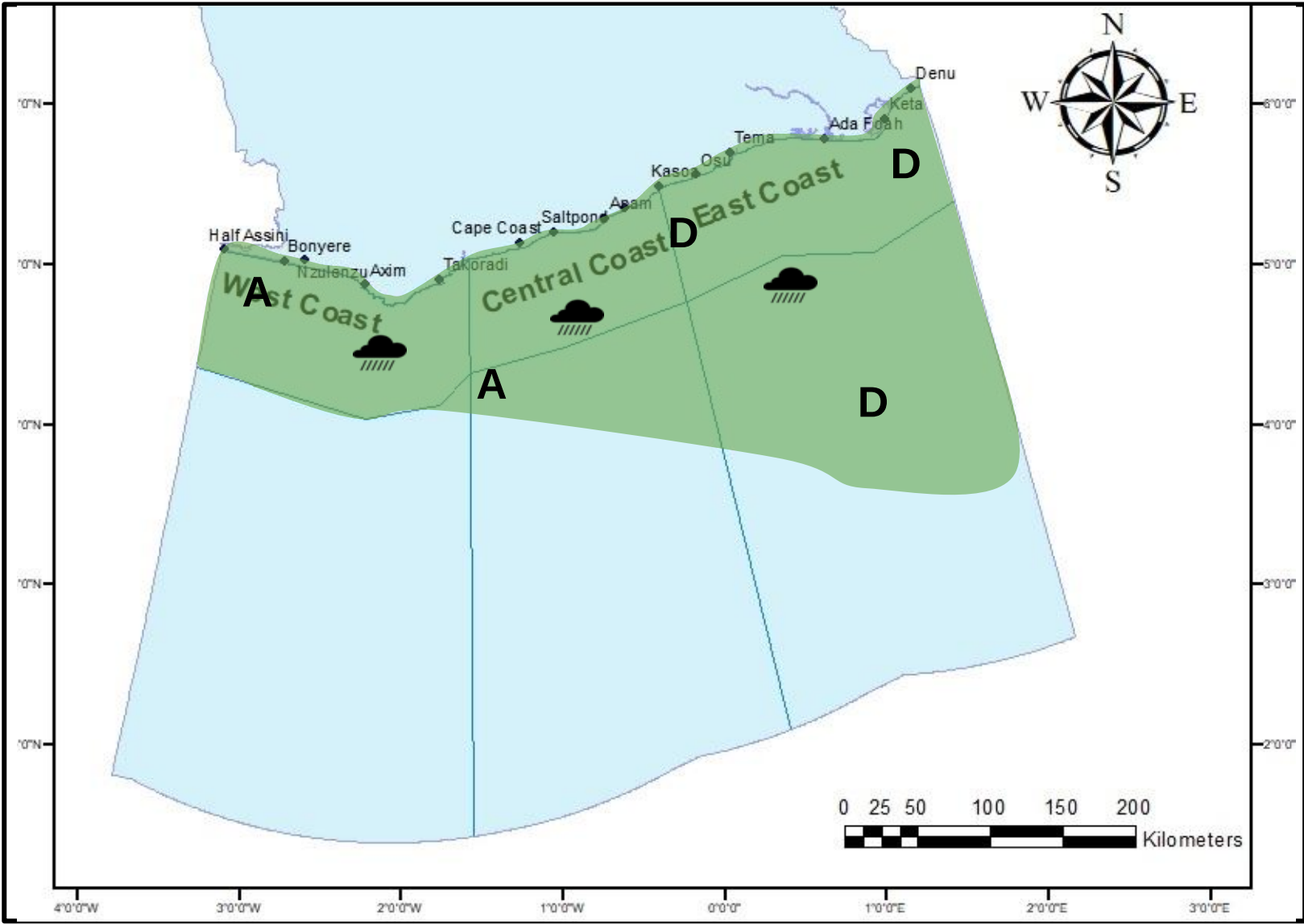

WEATHER SUMMARY: The prevailing cloudy weather conditions over the country’s marine space are expected to persist throughout the forecast period. However, isolated light to moderate rain with a 40-60% chance of occurrence is expected along the coastline and some offshore areas between midnight and the morning hours.

NB: Strong winds are expected over the maritime region during the validity period, particularly along the eastern coast.
