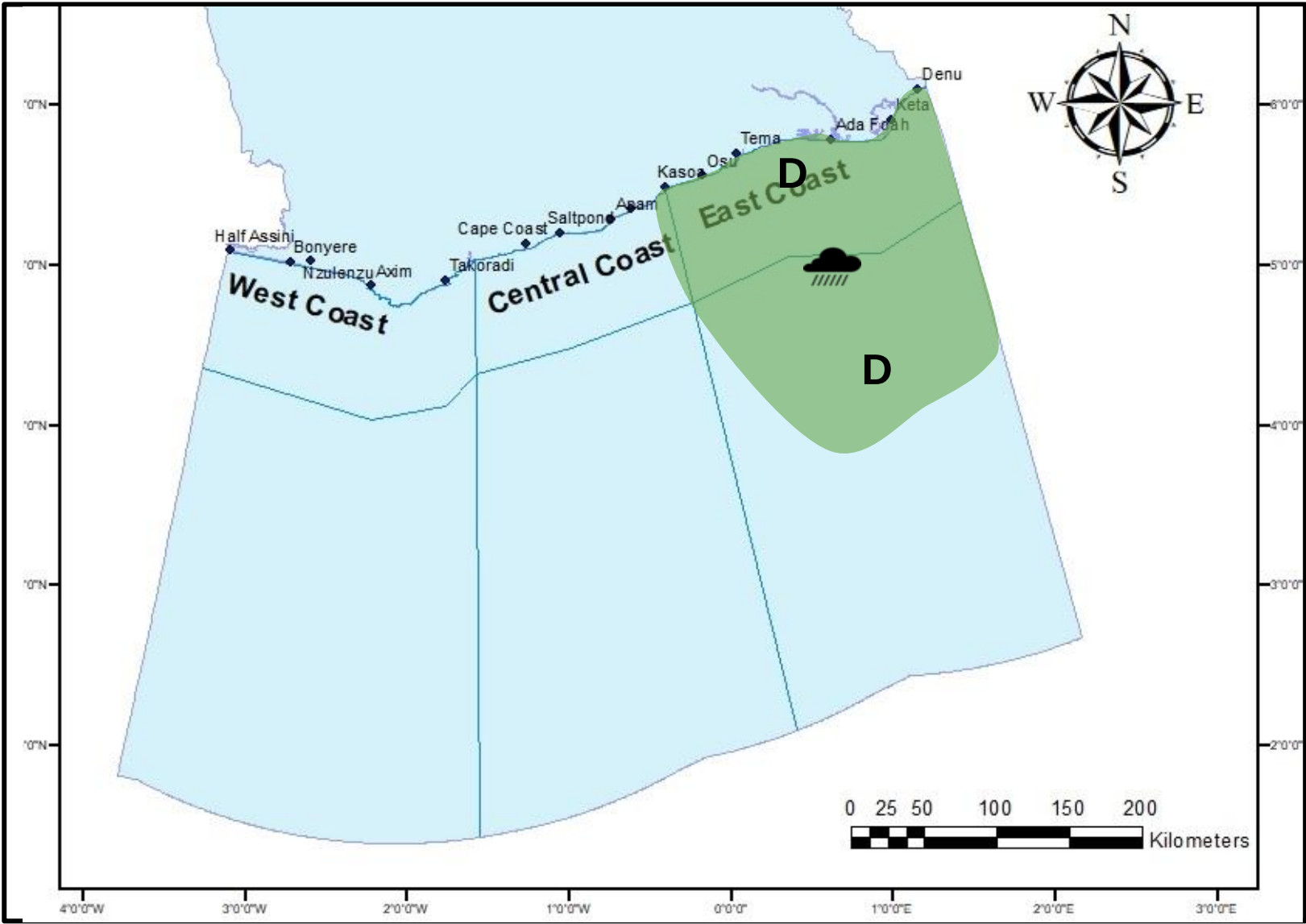

WEATHER SUMMARY: The nation’s marine space is expected to experience predominantly cloudy weather conditions for the entire duration of the forecast, with brief afternoon sunshine over the west coast. There is, however, a 40% likelihood of slight, isolated rainfall affecting the eastern coastal areas between the afternoon and evening hours.
