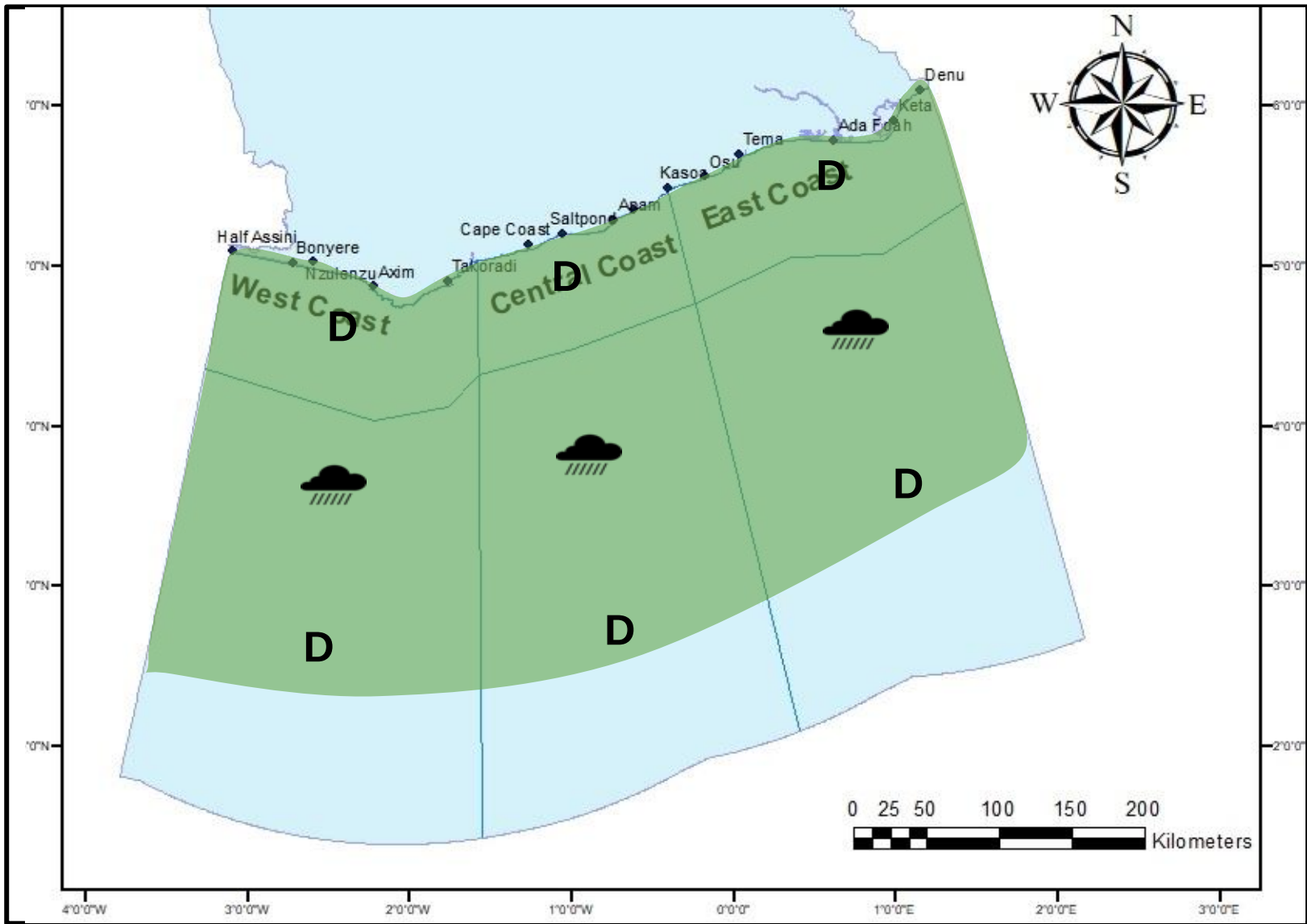

WEATHER SUMMARY: Cloudy weather conditions are anticipated to dominate the maritime space throughout the forecast period. There is, however, a 40–60% chance of isolated slight-to-moderate intermittent rainfall affecting both offshore and onshore areas, particularly between the afternoon and evening.

NB: Strong winds and rough sea state are expected over the marine region for the entire duration of the forecast.
