

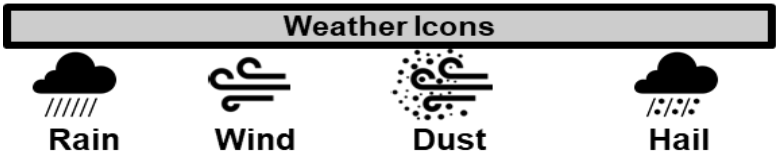
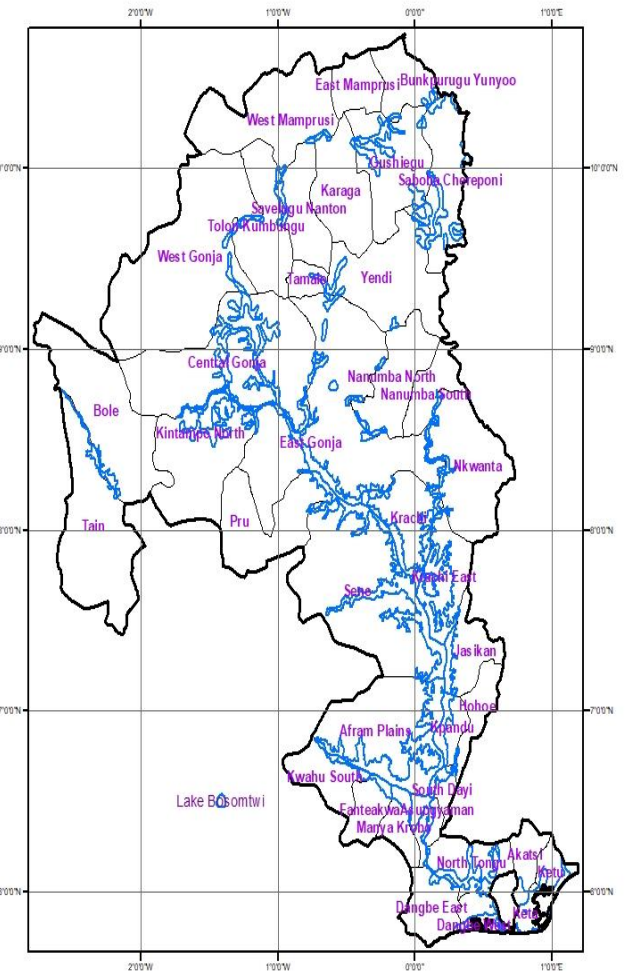
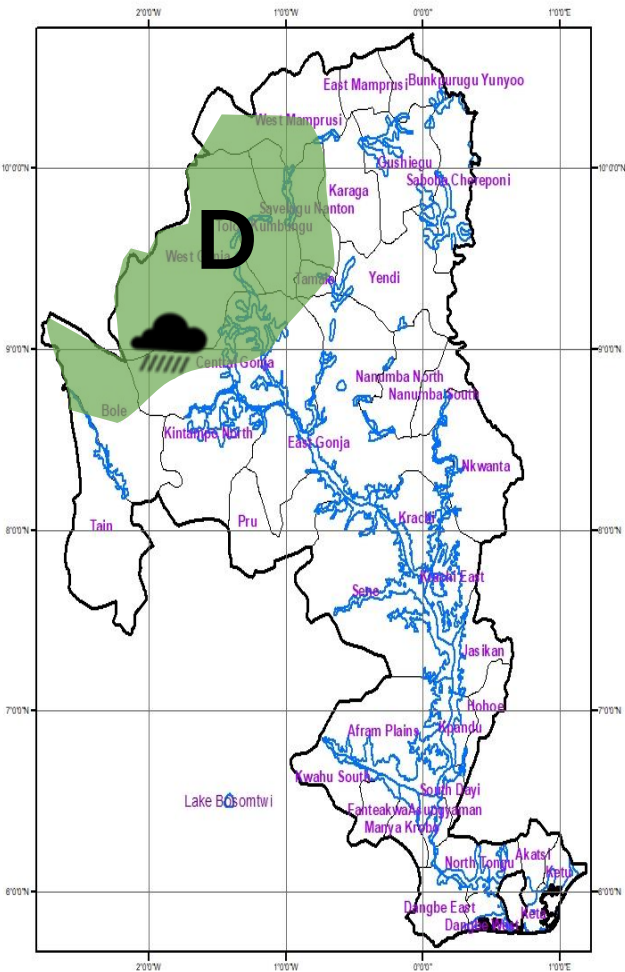
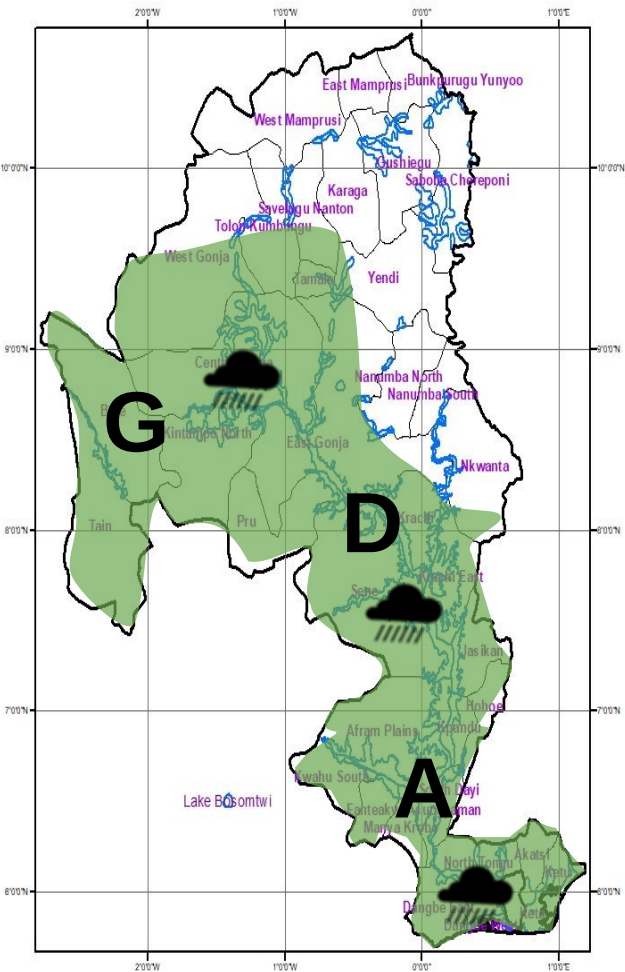


INLAND WATER IMPACT-BASED FORECAST

WEATHER SUMMARY

Cloudy to variably cloudy conditions are expected to prevail across most parts of the country from the afternoon through to the following morning. Slight rain will affect parts of the middle and southern sectors during the afternoon, while a 40% probability of rain is anticipated over the northern sector in the evening hours. By morning, mist is likely to develop over the middle and southern sectors, reducing visibility in some areas. Winds will be predominantly south to southwesterly, with speeds ranging from 7 to 14 knots, becoming slightly stronger along the coast.
