

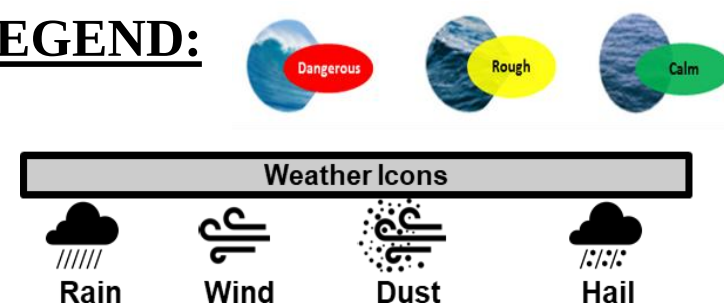

WEATHER SUMMARY
