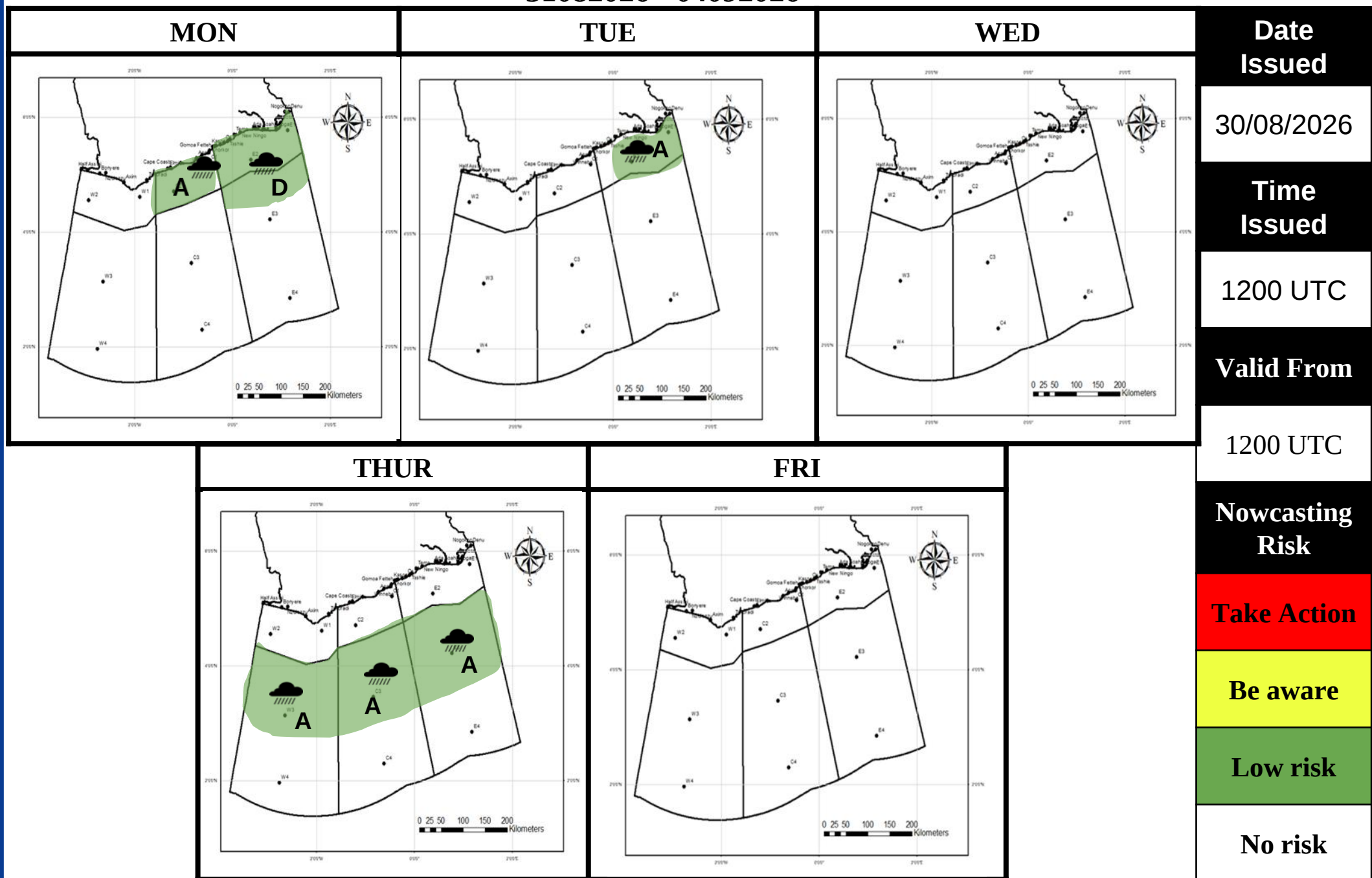

WEATHER SUMMARY

Variable cloudiness is expected to prevail over the coastal and maritime areas of Ghana throughout the week, with periods of sunshine likely to occur mainly during the afternoon hours. There is a 30–40% probability of light rain or drizzle, particularly along the coast and over the offshore areas. However, sea conditions are expected to remain rough throughout the week.
