Summary

Week 1:

Rainfall: Below normal rainfall is expected across most parts of the country with the exception of the East coast which is likely to record normal conditions.

Temperature: Above normal temperatures are expected over the entire country except for places in the West coast likely to record below normal temperatures.

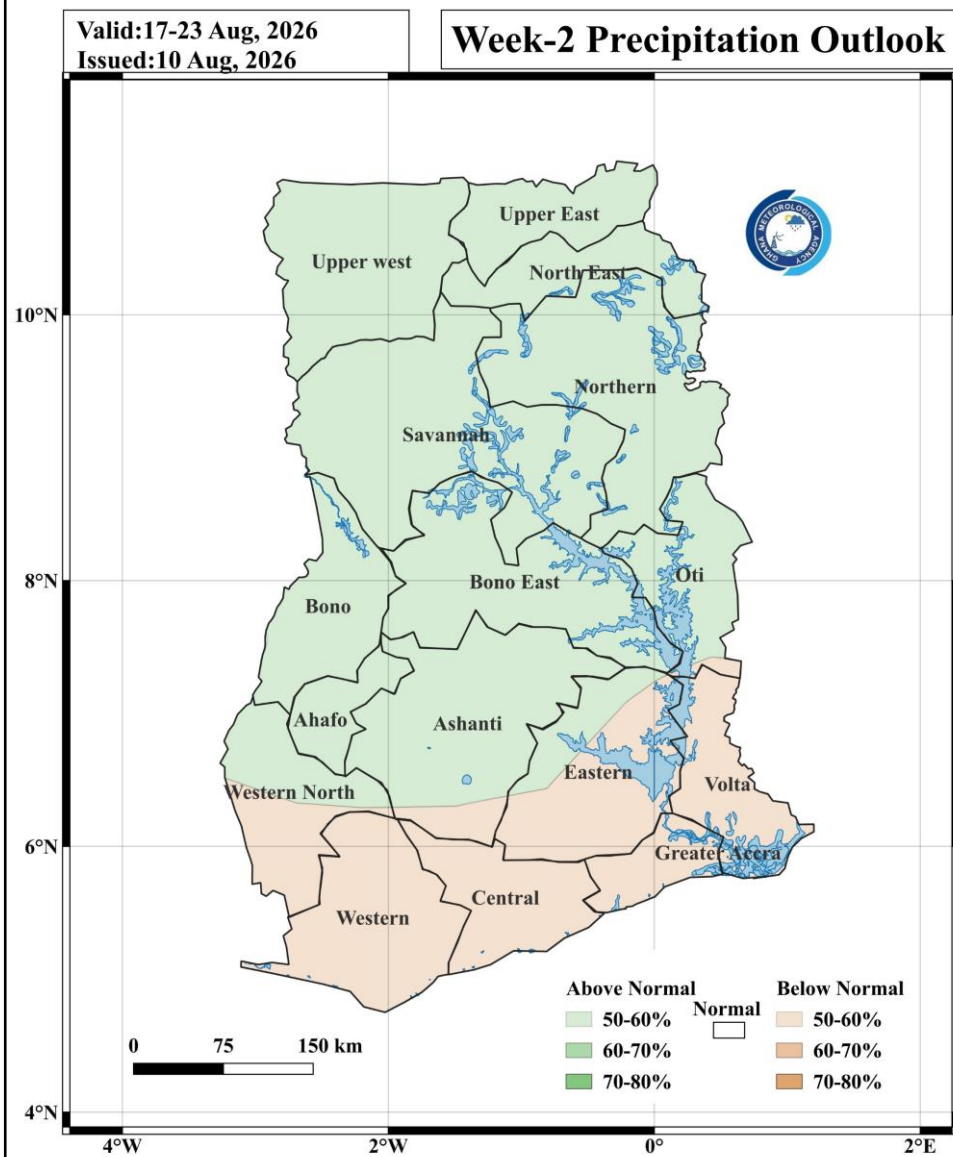

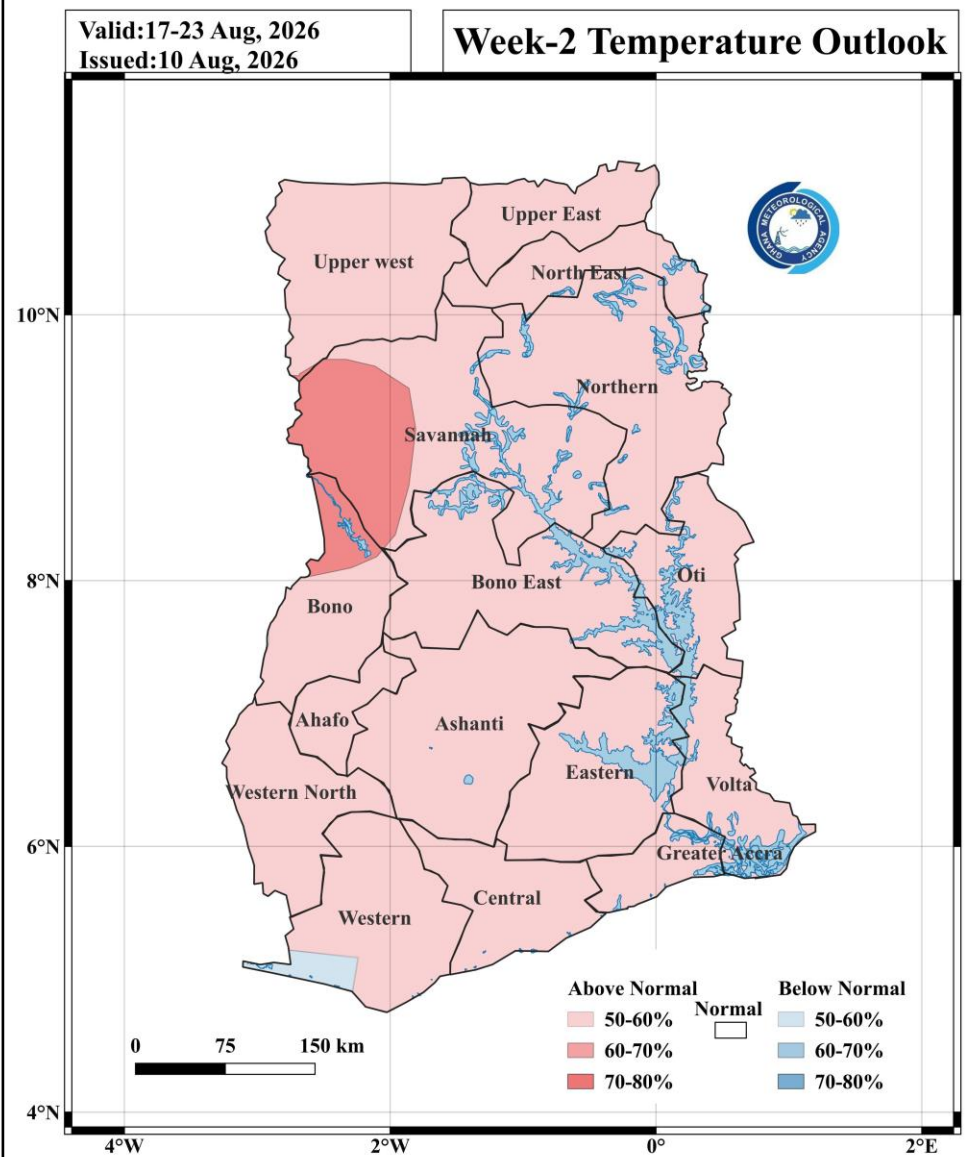

Summary

Week 2:

Rainfall: Below normal rainfall is expected in the entire coast and parts of the Forest zone. The rest of the country is expected record above normal rainfall.

Temperature: Generally, the country is expected to record above normal temperatures with the exception of the western portions of the West coast.



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Advisory

- For the 1st week, below normal rainfall is expected across most parts of the country with the exception of the East coast. Individuals are advised to store water whenever it rains and ensure prudent use of available water.
- In most parts of the country, above normal temperatures call for adequate hydration and limited sun exposure during peak afternoon hours.
- As the period progresses into the 2nd week, below normal rainfall is expected in the entire coast and parts of the Forest zone. Generally, above normal temperatures will persist over the rest of the country – staying hydrated is advised.
- **The public is encouraged to stay informed by following daily weather updates from the Ghana Meteorological Agency.**
