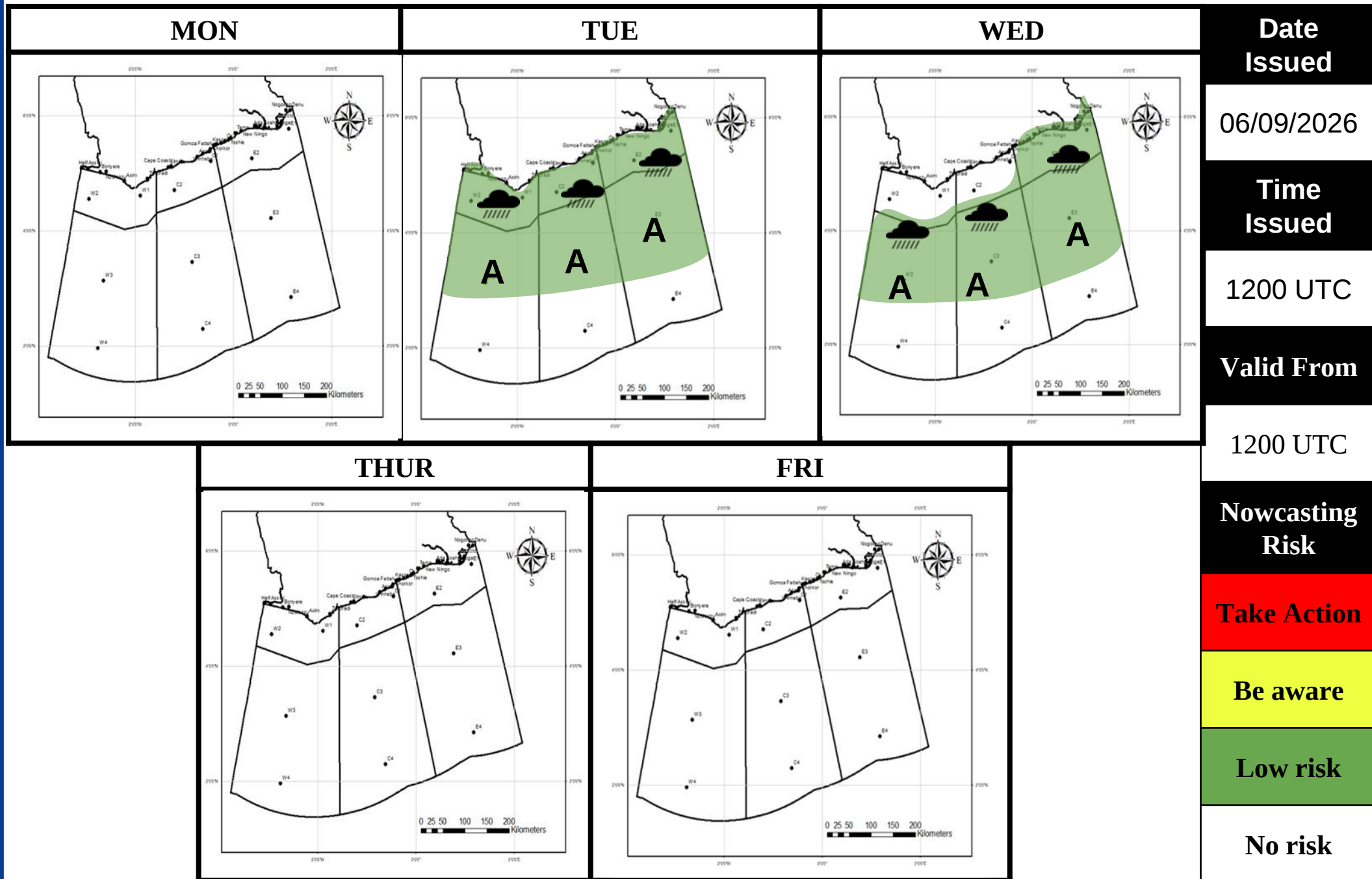


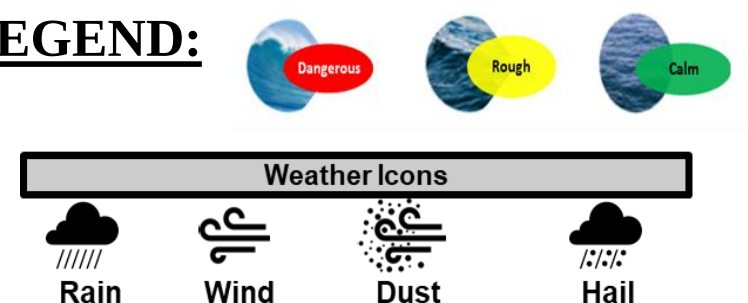

WEATHER SUMMARY

Variable cloud cover is anticipated to dominate the coastal and maritime space of Ghana for the week, with chances of sunshine mainly in the afternoons. There is a 30% probability of light rain or drizzle, especially along the coastline and in offshore areas, particularly on Tuesday and Wednesday. However, rough sea conditions are expected to persist throughout the week.
