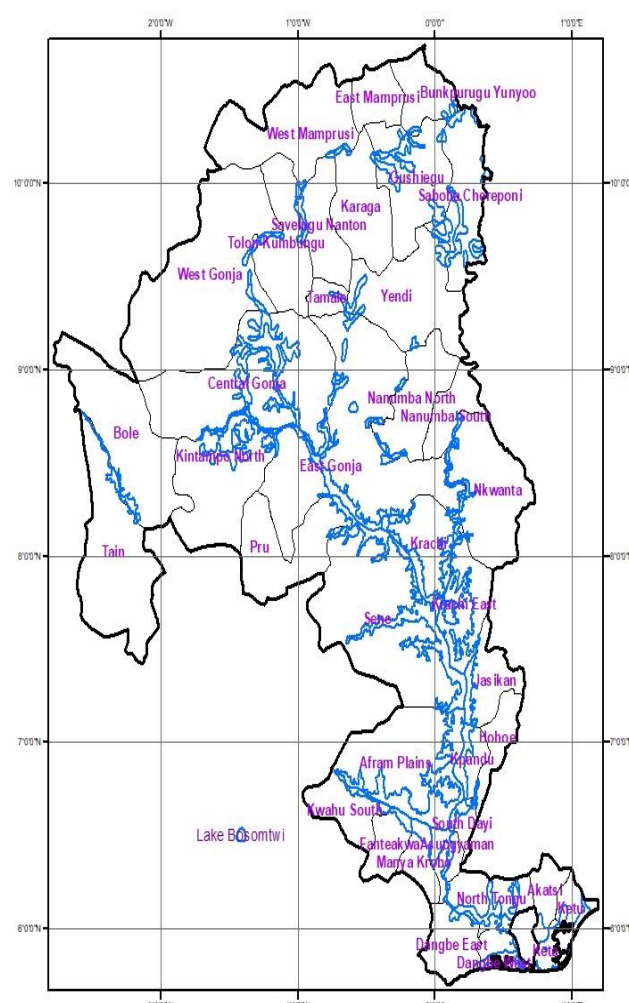
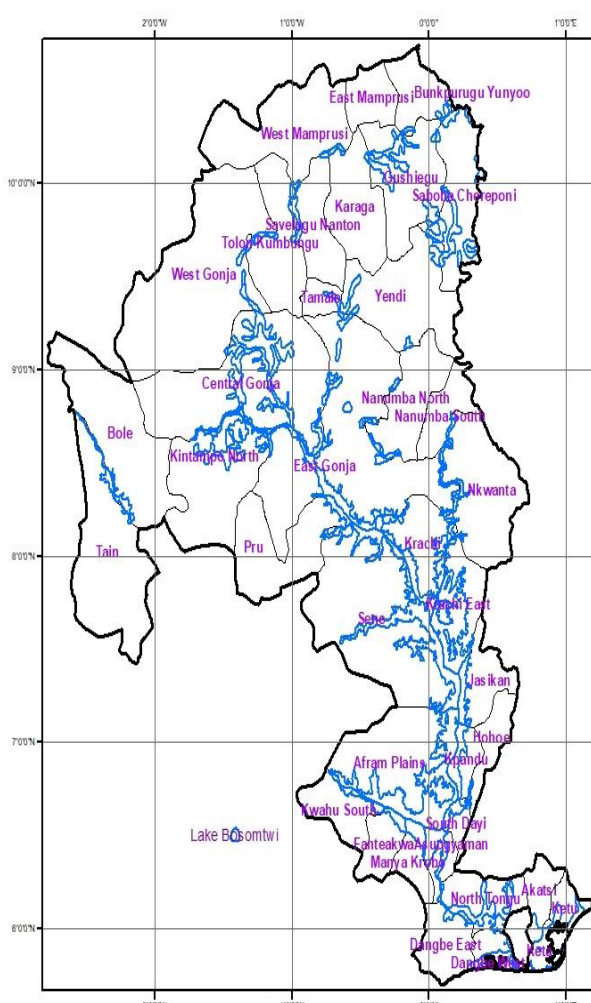
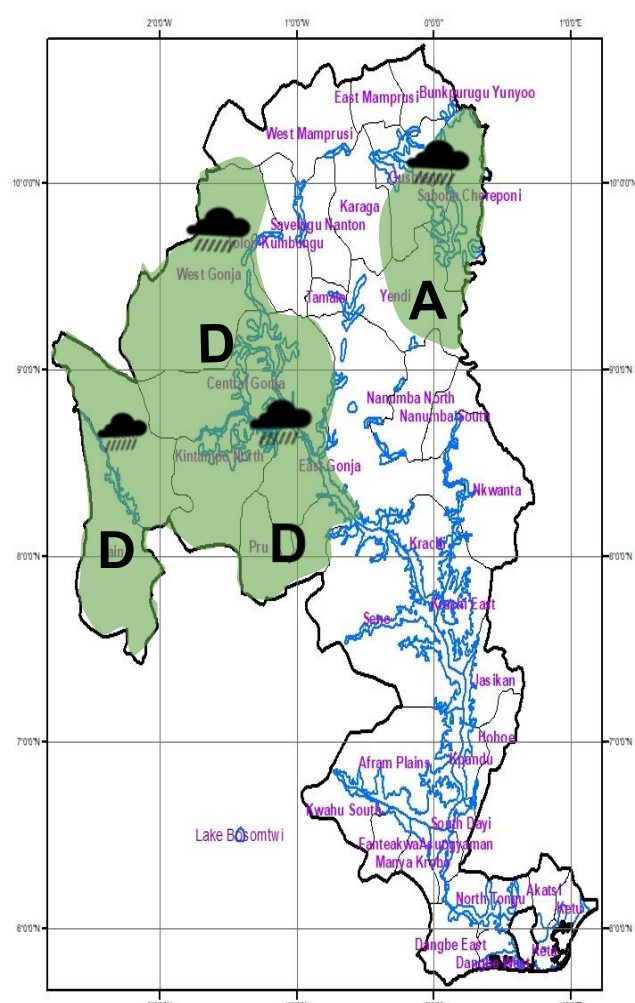
WEATHER SUMMARY

Weather conditions over the lake are expected to be mostly cloudy across the northern half tonight, while the southern half will experience variable cloudiness. There is a 30–40% probability of thunderstorms and rain affecting isolated areas within the northern sector during the evening. Mist and fog patches are expected to reduce visibility over hilly and forested areas early in the morning.
