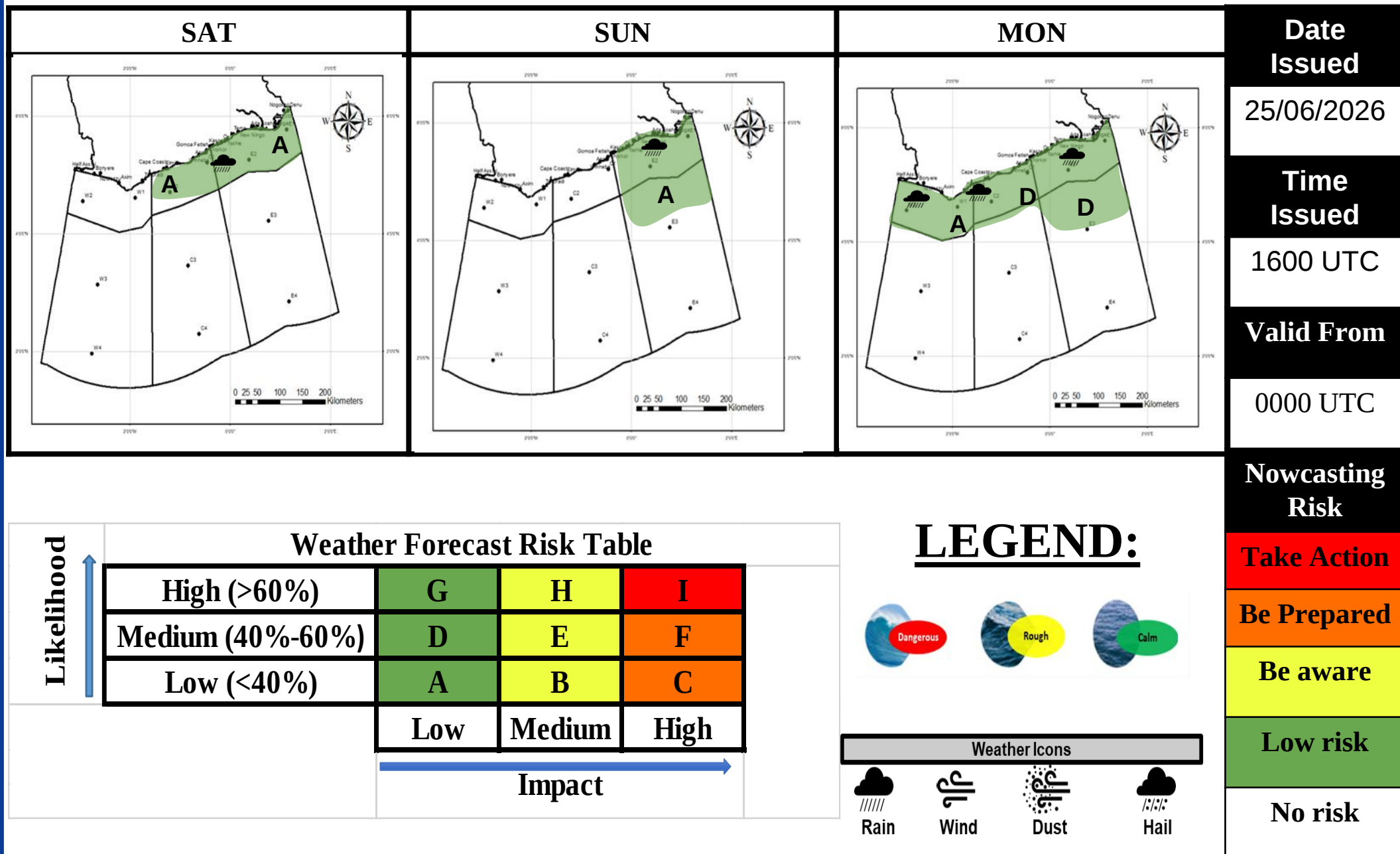




OUTLOOK FOR GHANA'S MARINE SPACE IMPACT-BASED FORECAST (WEEKEND) 26092026 - 28092026

WEATHER SUMMARY

During the weekend, the nation's marine region is expected to be mostly cloudy, with occasional periods of sunshine along the coastline in the afternoon. Isolated slight to moderate showers are anticipated to occur over parts of the onshore and offshore areas during the forecast period, with the possibility of gusty winds. The state of the sea is expected to remain calm on Saturday but gradually deteriorate to rough conditions from Sunday. Strong north-easterly currents are also likely to prevail along the western coast.
