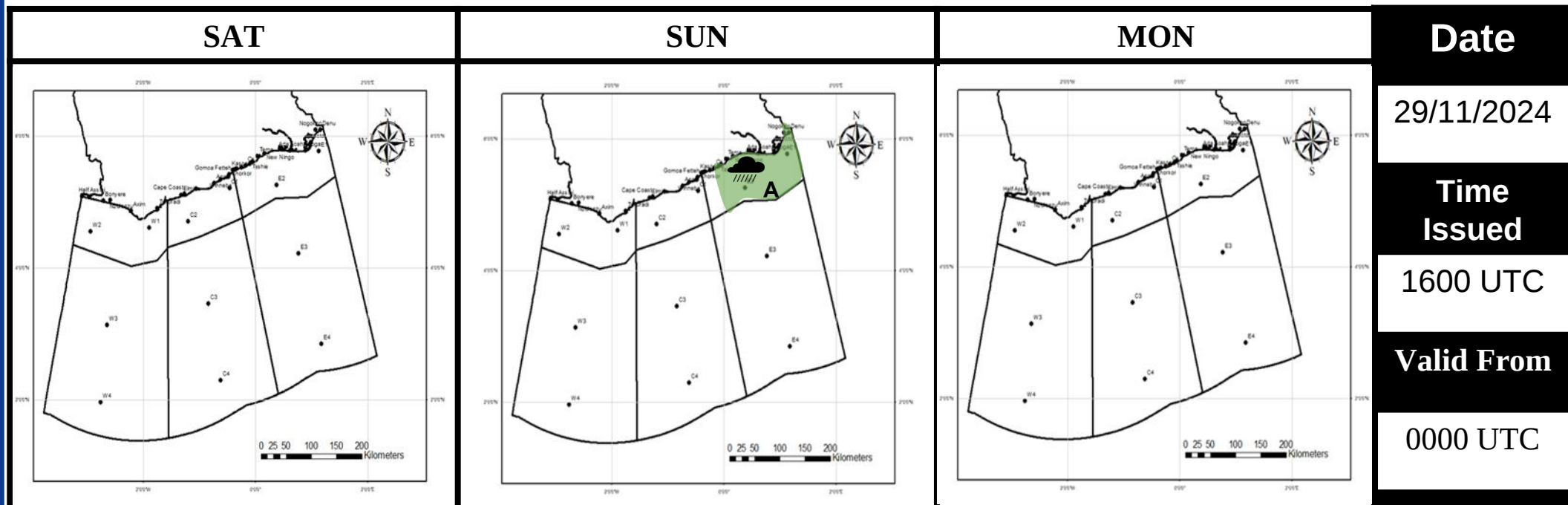

WEATHER SUMMARY
