

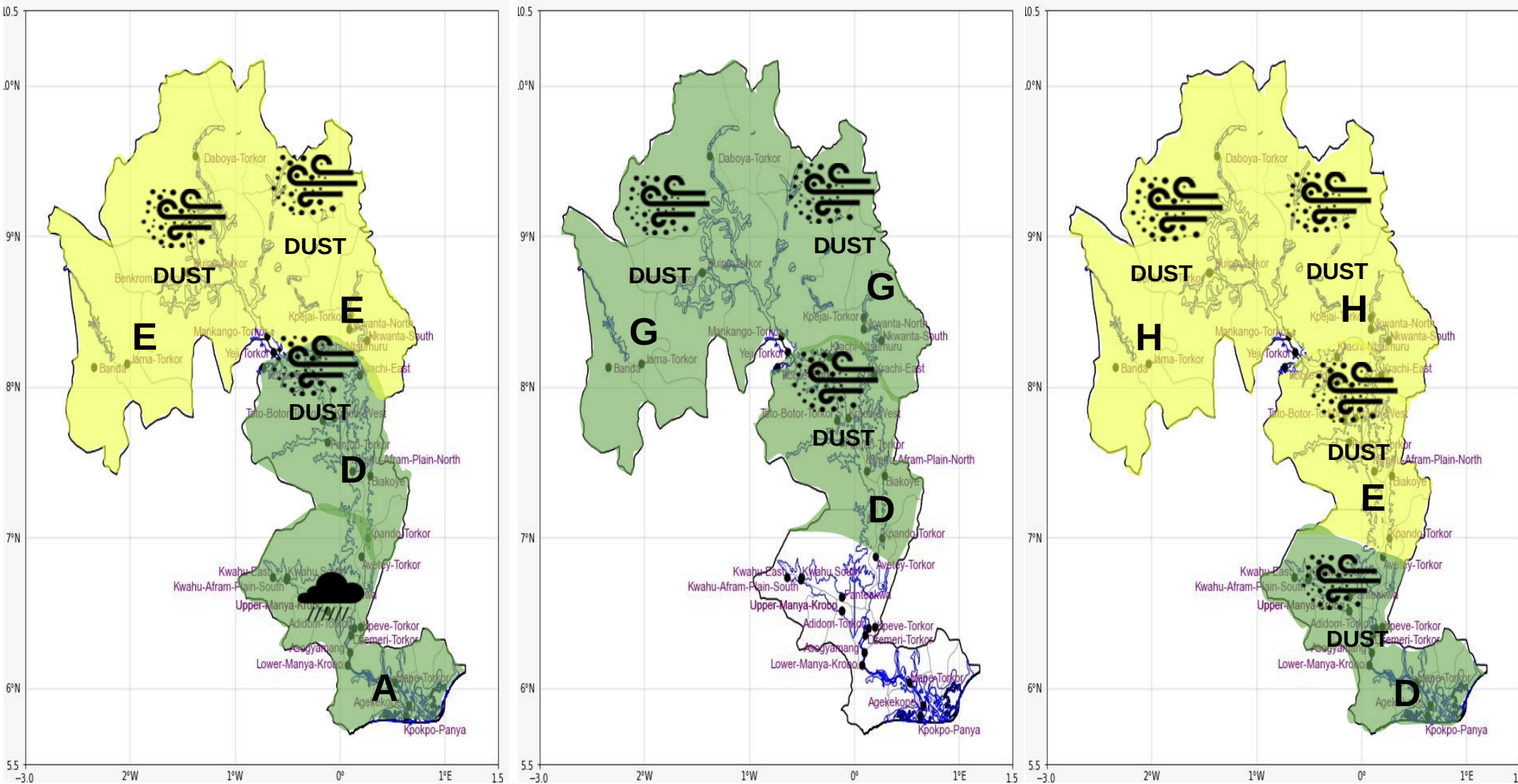


INLAND WATER IMPACT-BASED FORECAST

WEATHER SUMMARY

Fairly dry and slightly hazy conditions are expected in the northern half of the lake area, while the southern half will observe few clouds and some isolated showers over areas with lush vegetation this evening. In the morning, visibility will reduce due to misty weather, improving gradually as the day progresses.
