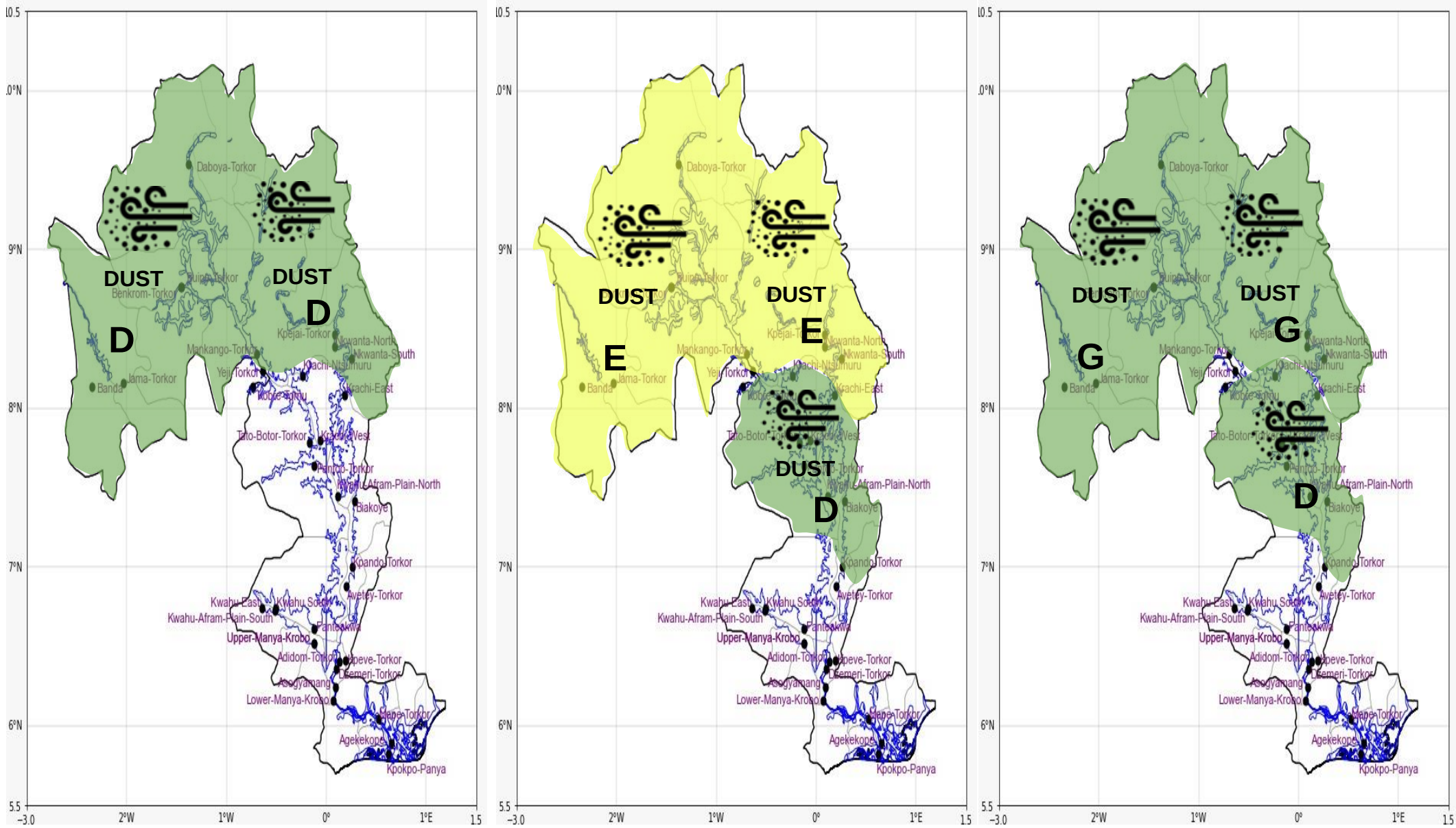




INLAND WATER IMPACT-BASED FORECAST  
WEATHER SUMMARY

Mist patches are expected to form over the lake and its surroundings which will decrease visibility in the early morning hours. Fairly dry and hazy conditions will persist throughout the forecast period, especially in the northern sector of the lake and its surrounding communities. Sunny periods are expected as the day progresses into the afternoon hours.
