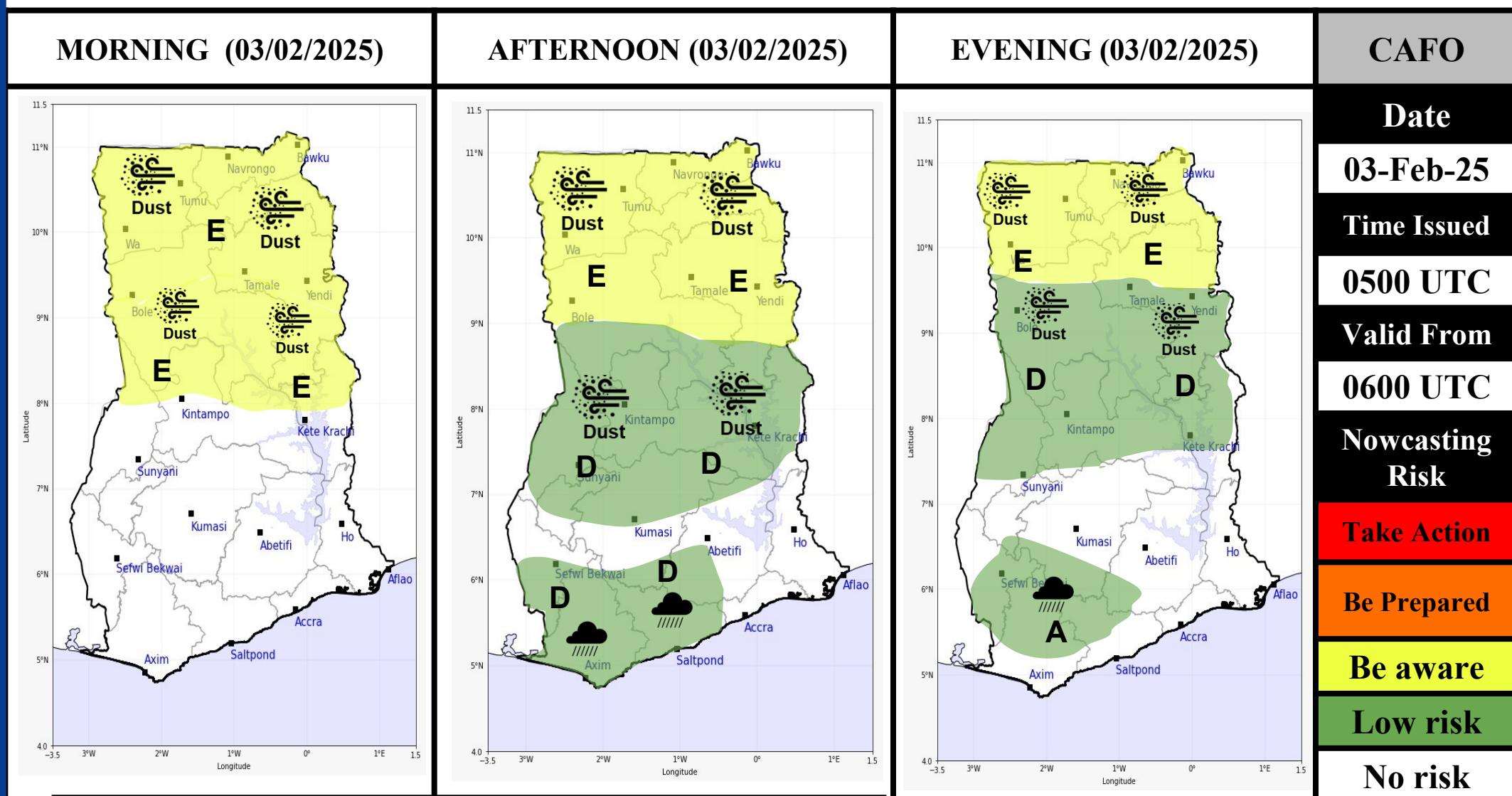
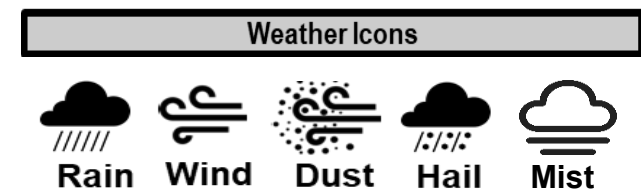

SUMMARY: Mist or fog patches will form over most areas within the southern half of the country this morning. As the day unfolds, sunny conditions amidst clouds formation are expected. This clouds formation is anticipated to give way for localised thunderstorms or rain along the coastline and few inland areas from late afternoon into the evening. However, the northern half will be predominantly fairly dry and hazy throughout the forecast period. Visibility range across the country is expected from 200 meters to 9000 meters.

- Motorists are advised to use fog lights and drive within appropriate speed limits due to deteriorated visibility.**
