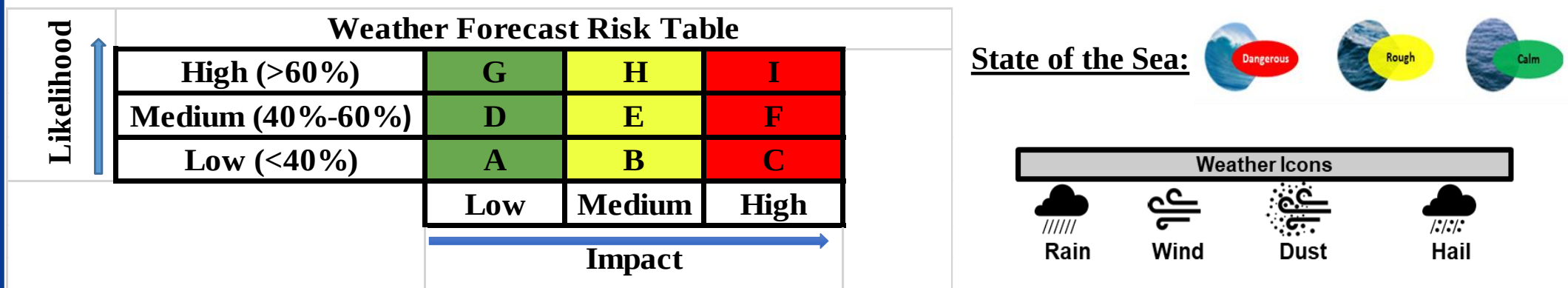

WEATHER SUMMARY

Variable cloud cover is expected over the maritime areas throughout the week with reduced visibility due to mist or fog patches early in the morning. Sunny periods are expected during the afternoon hours. There is a 40% likelihood of isolated thunderstorms and rain over the western coast on Thursday and Friday. The sea state is expected to be rough throughout the forecast period.
