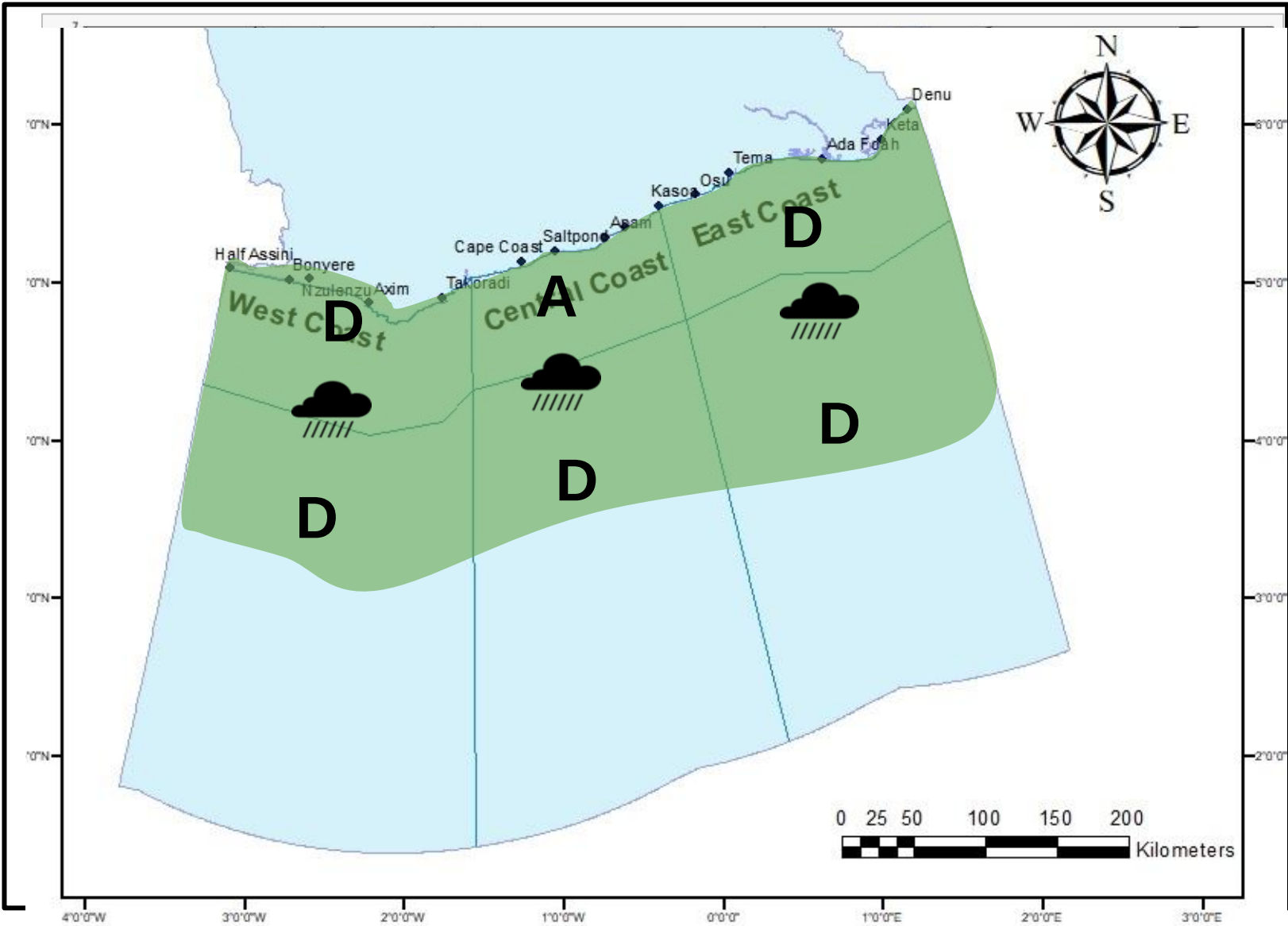

WEATHER SUMMARY: The country's maritime region is expected to undergo fluctuating cloud cover during the duration of the forecast. However, there exists a 40% chance of sporadic light to moderate rainfall, potentially accompanied by thunderstorms, affecting both onshore and offshore areas from this afternoon until the evening.

NB: The state of the sea is expected to be very rough with strong winds.
