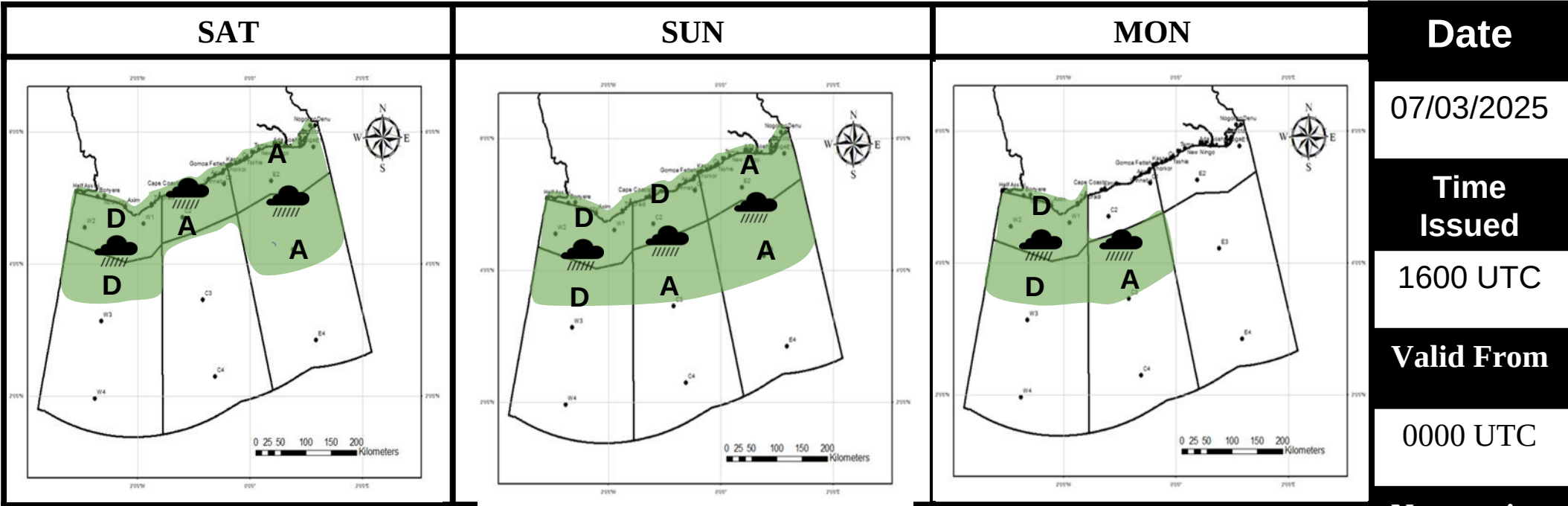

WEATHER SUMMARY

Varying degrees of cloudiness will be experienced across the country's marine space throughout this weekend, with periods of sunshine in the afternoons. Nonetheless, there is a 40% likelihood of isolated light to moderate rain, with or without thunderstorms both onshore and offshore during the forecast duration. Wave heights are anticipated to steadily increase, resulting in rough sea conditions as the weekend advances.
