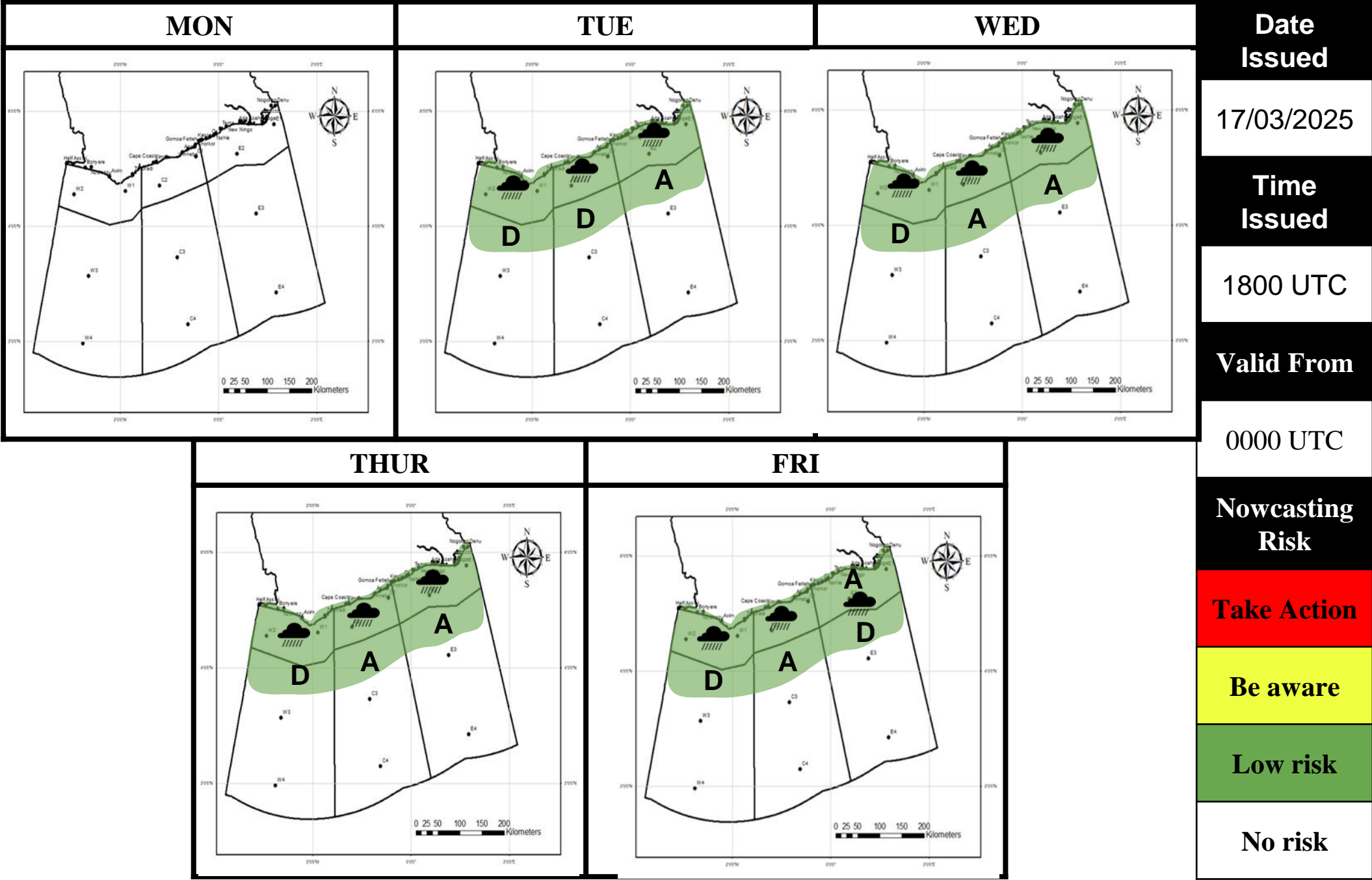

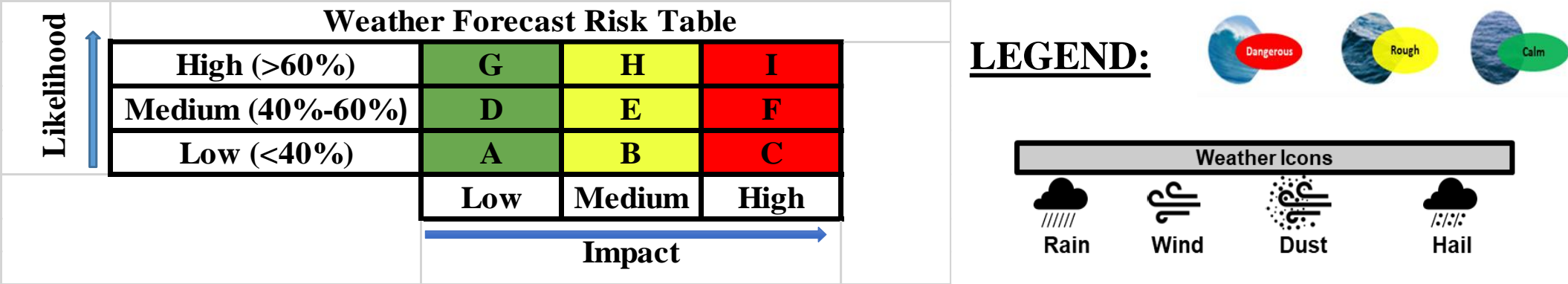

WEATHER SUMMARY

This week, the country's marine space will experience varying levels of cloud cover, with occasional sunny spells in the afternoons. However, there is a 40% chance of rain, ranging in intensity, with or without thunderstorms, both onshore and offshore throughout the forecast period. The sea is expected to remain rough for the entire duration of the forecast.
