



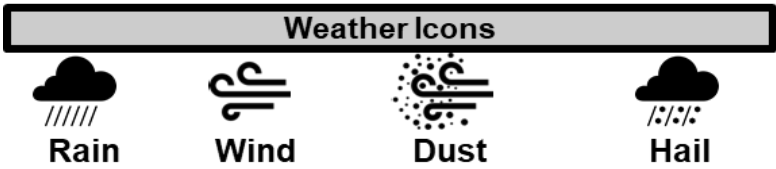
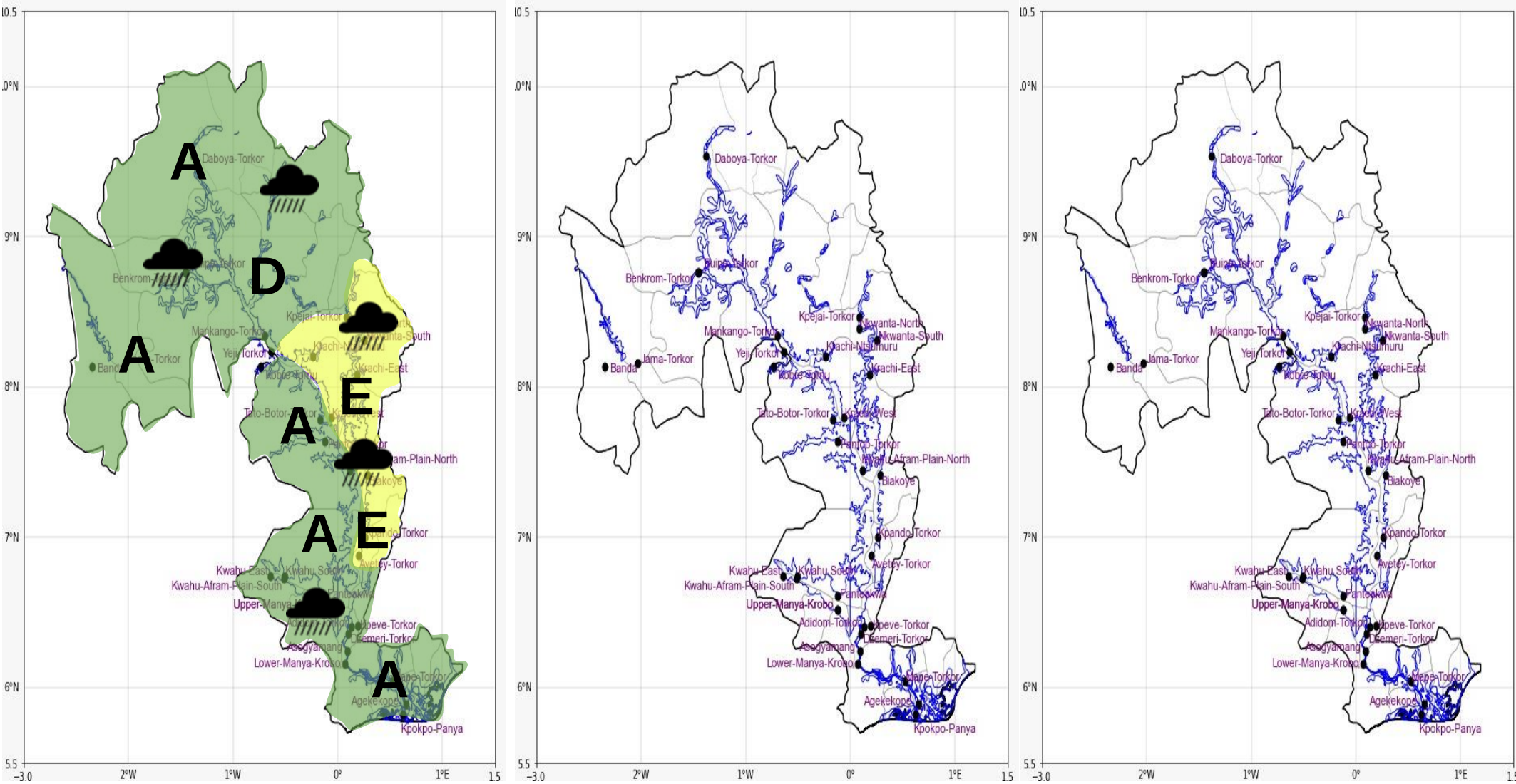
INLAND WATER IMPACT-BASED FORECAST

WEATHER SUMMARY

The lake and its environs are expected to experience generally cloudy conditions with rainstorms of varying intensities, with or without thunderstorms across the entire lake and its enclave this evening. Early morning visibility will be reduced due to mist over some middle sector areas and partly cloudy as the morning advances into the afternoon.

NB: The storm will be accompanied by strong winds.
