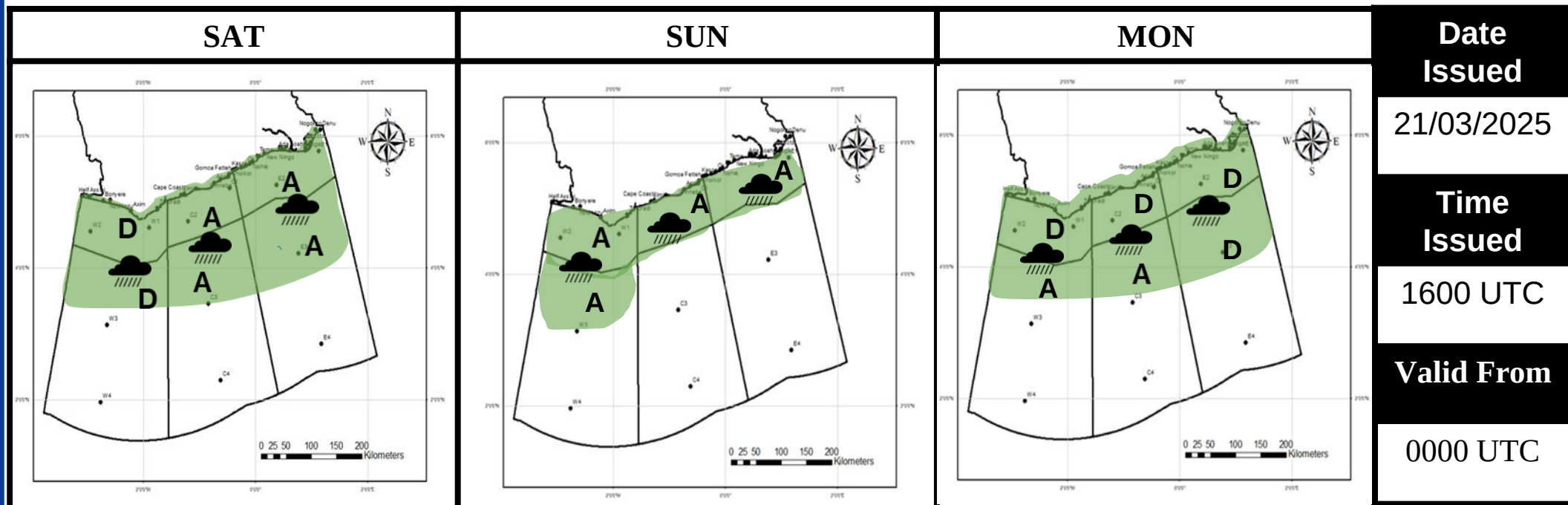

Moreover, sea conditions are anticipated to become rough as the weekend progresses.
