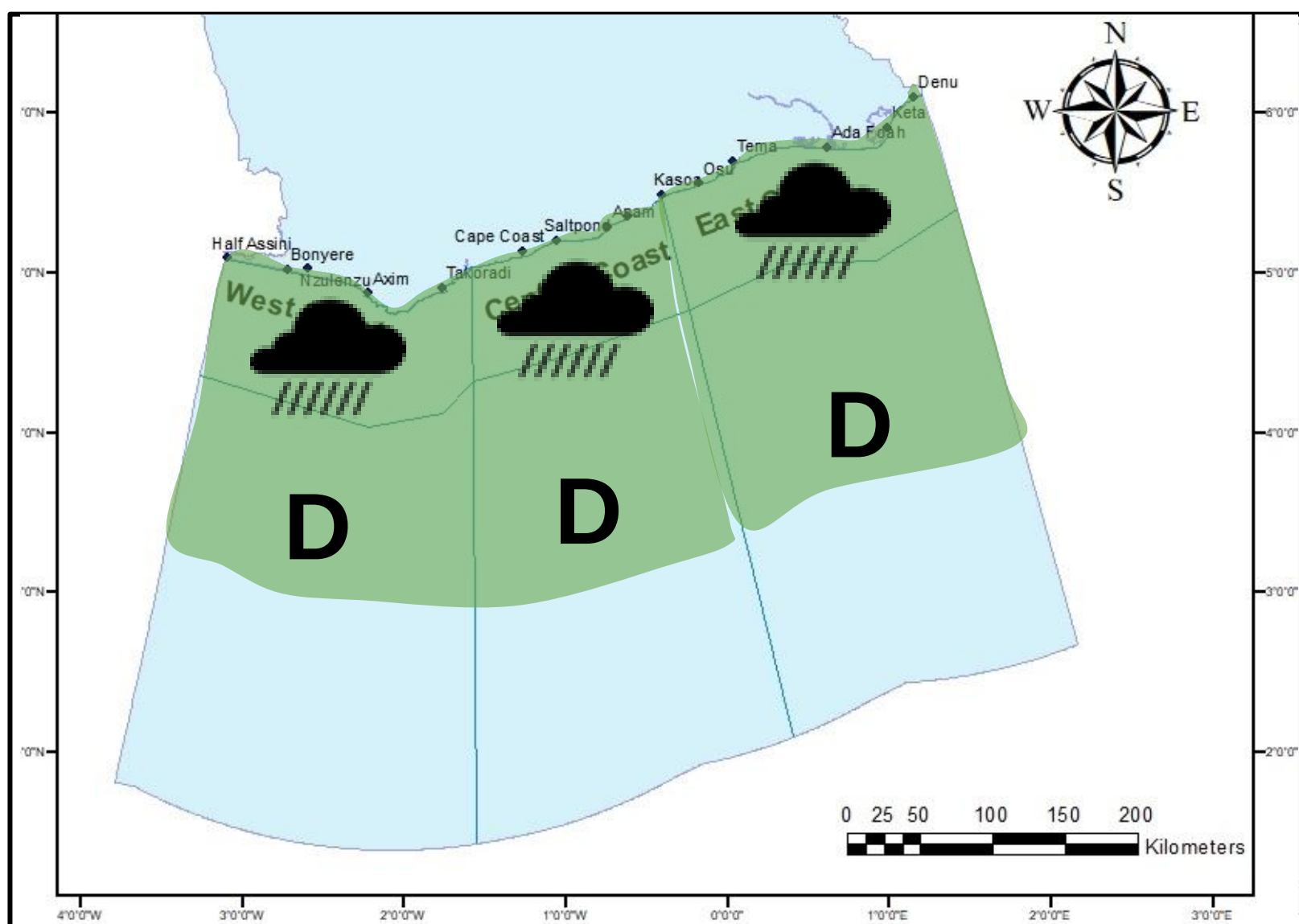

WEATHER SUMMARY: The ongoing cloud cover and thunderstorms in the country's marine region are predicted to continue during the forecast period. There is a 40% chance of additional thunderstorms and rains with different intensities across both onshore and offshore regions from this afternoon into the night.

NB: A VERY ROUGH SEA STATE AND STRONG WINDS ARE EXPECTED OVER THE ENTIRE MARITIME SPACE, ESPECIALLY OVER THE EAST COAST.
