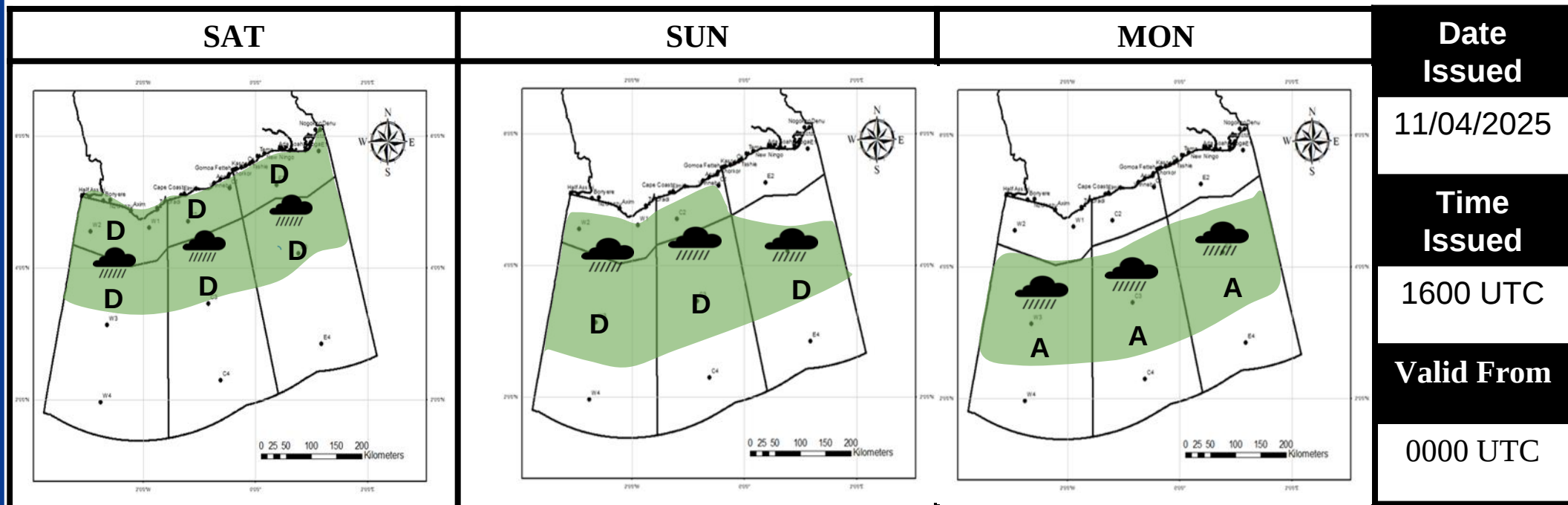

WEATHER SUMMARY

The state of the sea is expected to remain rough throughout the forecast period. Variable cloud cover will be experienced across the country's marine space throughout this weekend, with periods of sunshine in the afternoons. However, there is a 40% probability of rain of varying intensities, with or without thunderstorms over the coastline and offshore during the forecast duration.
