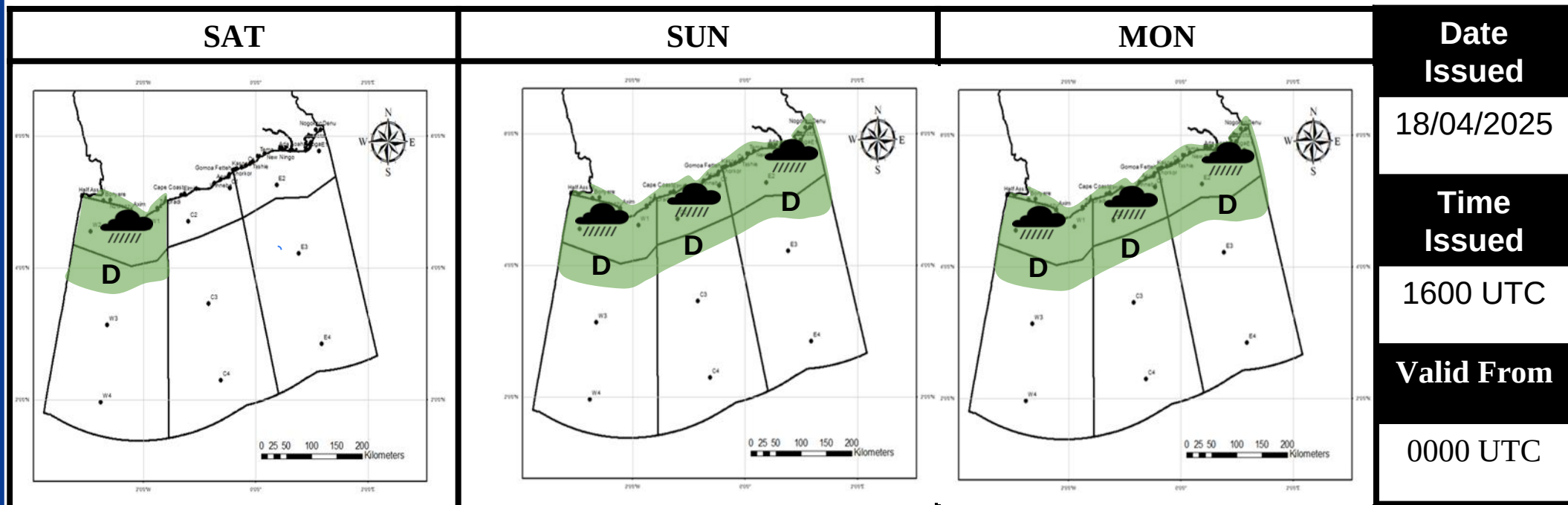


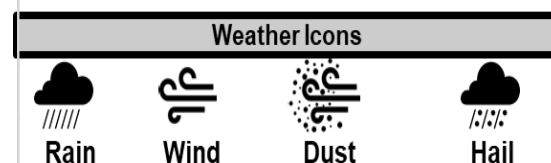

WEATHER SUMMARY

The state of the sea is anticipated to remain rough throughout the forecast interval. Clouds of varying intensities will persist across the marine space with periods of sunshine in the afternoons during the course of the weekend. However, isolated rain is expected over the west coast during Saturday morning. The marine space is expected to experience intermittent rainfalls with thunderstorms between Sunday evening and Monday morning.
