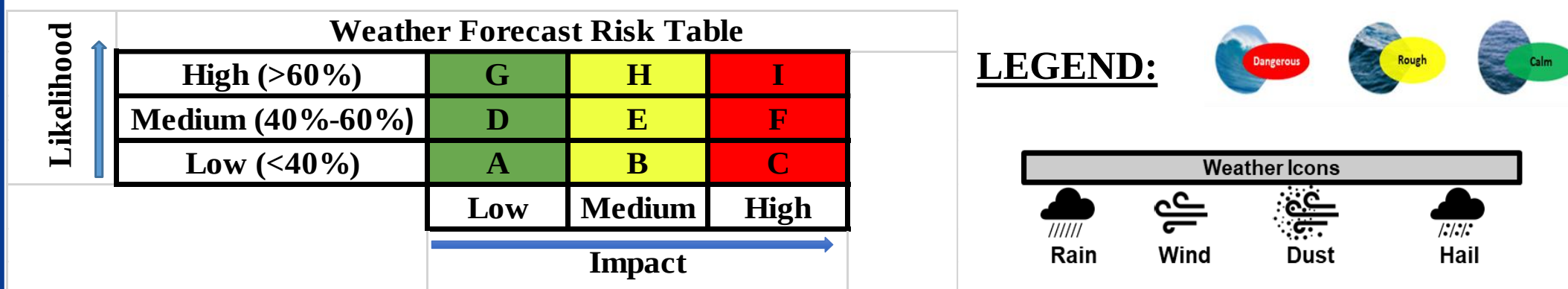
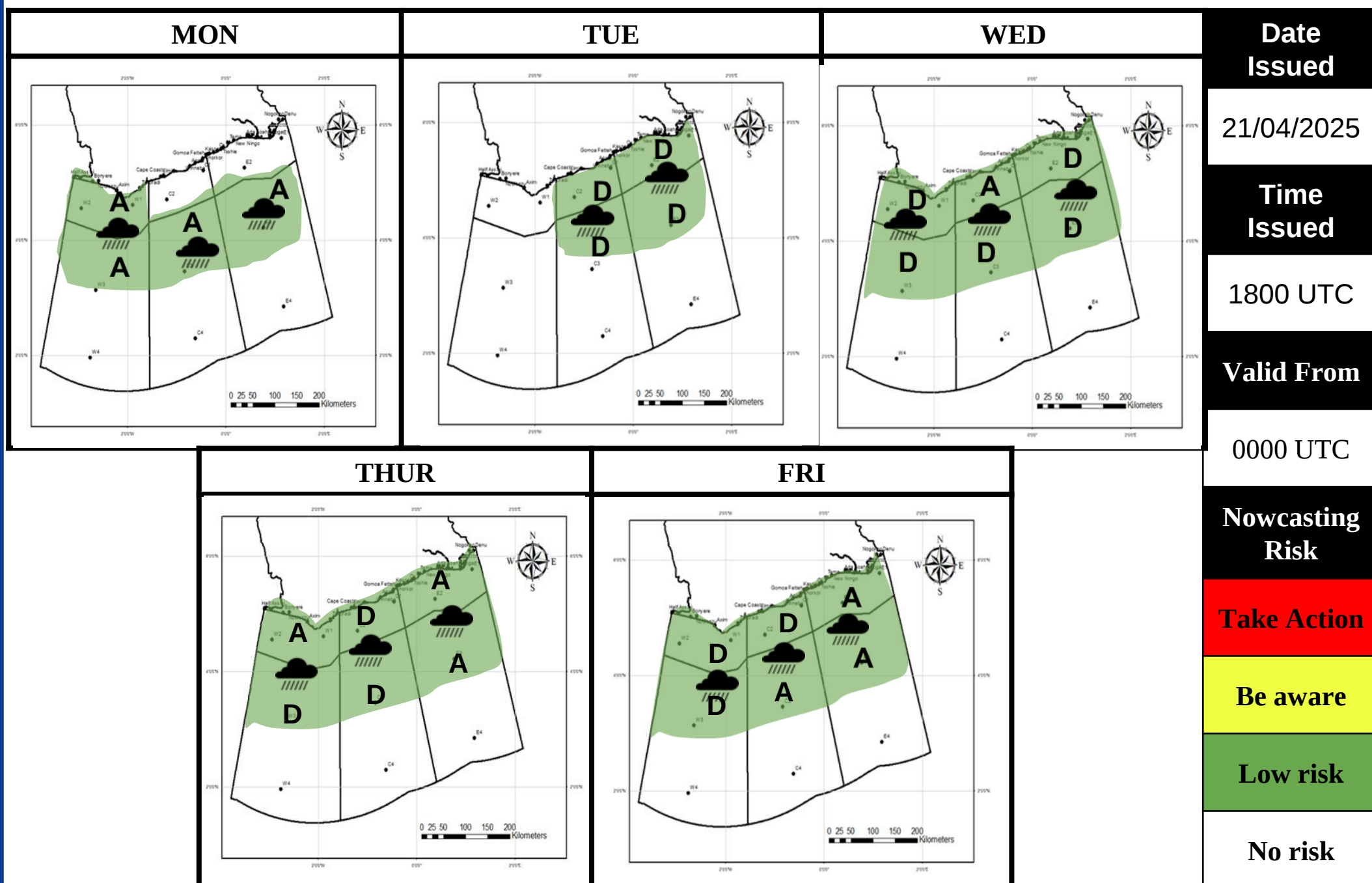

WEATHER SUMMARY

For the duration of the forecast, sea conditions are expected to stay rough. It is anticipated that the country's maritime region will experience variable levels of cloud cover throughout the week, with sporadic sunny spells in the afternoon. On the other hand, over the week, there is a 40% chance of thunderstorms and mild to moderate rain in lots of coastal and offshore locations.
