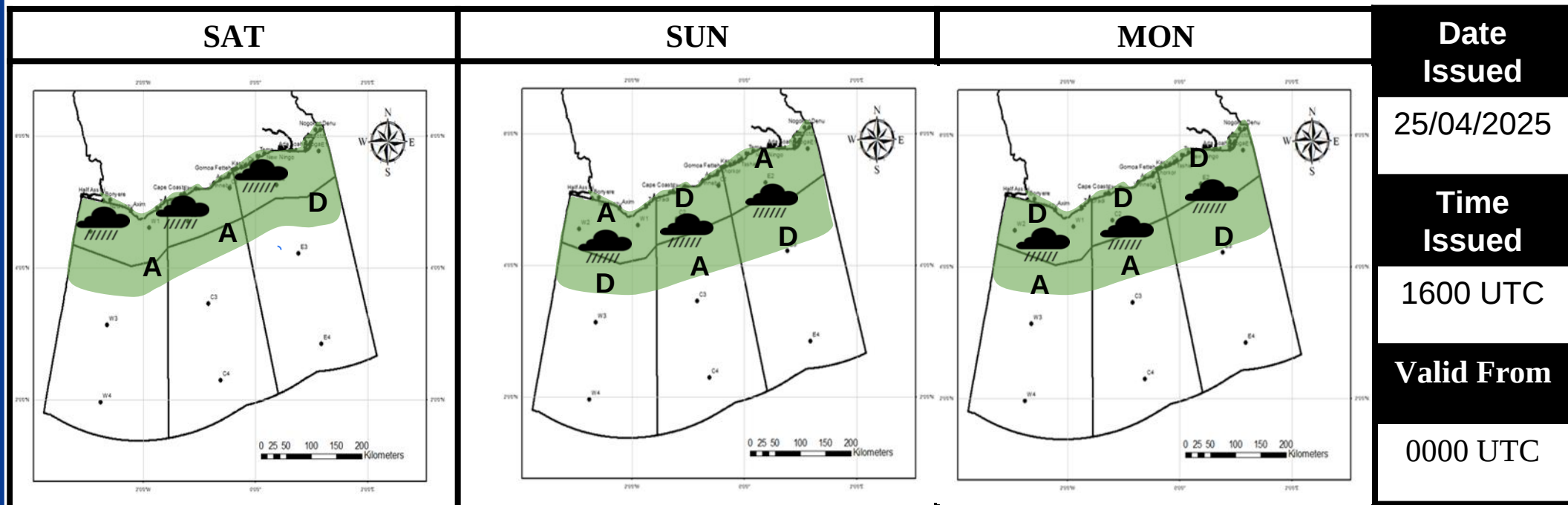

WEATHER SUMMARY
