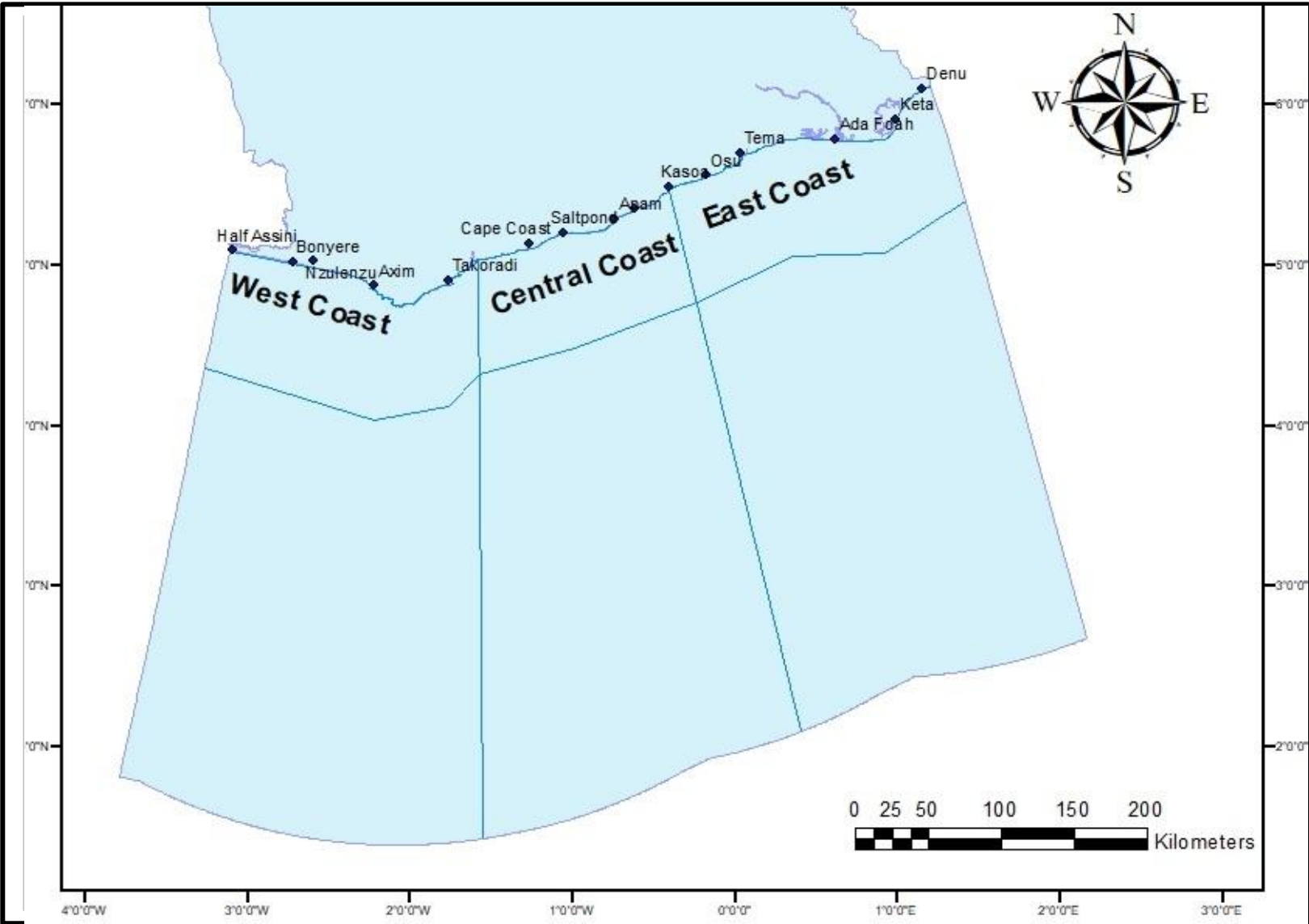

WEATHER SUMMARY: The significant wave height is expected to increase, ranging between 1.2 and 1.8 meters, indicating a rough sea state. While no significant rainfall is anticipated, variably cloudy conditions are expected tonight through mid-morning tomorrow.
