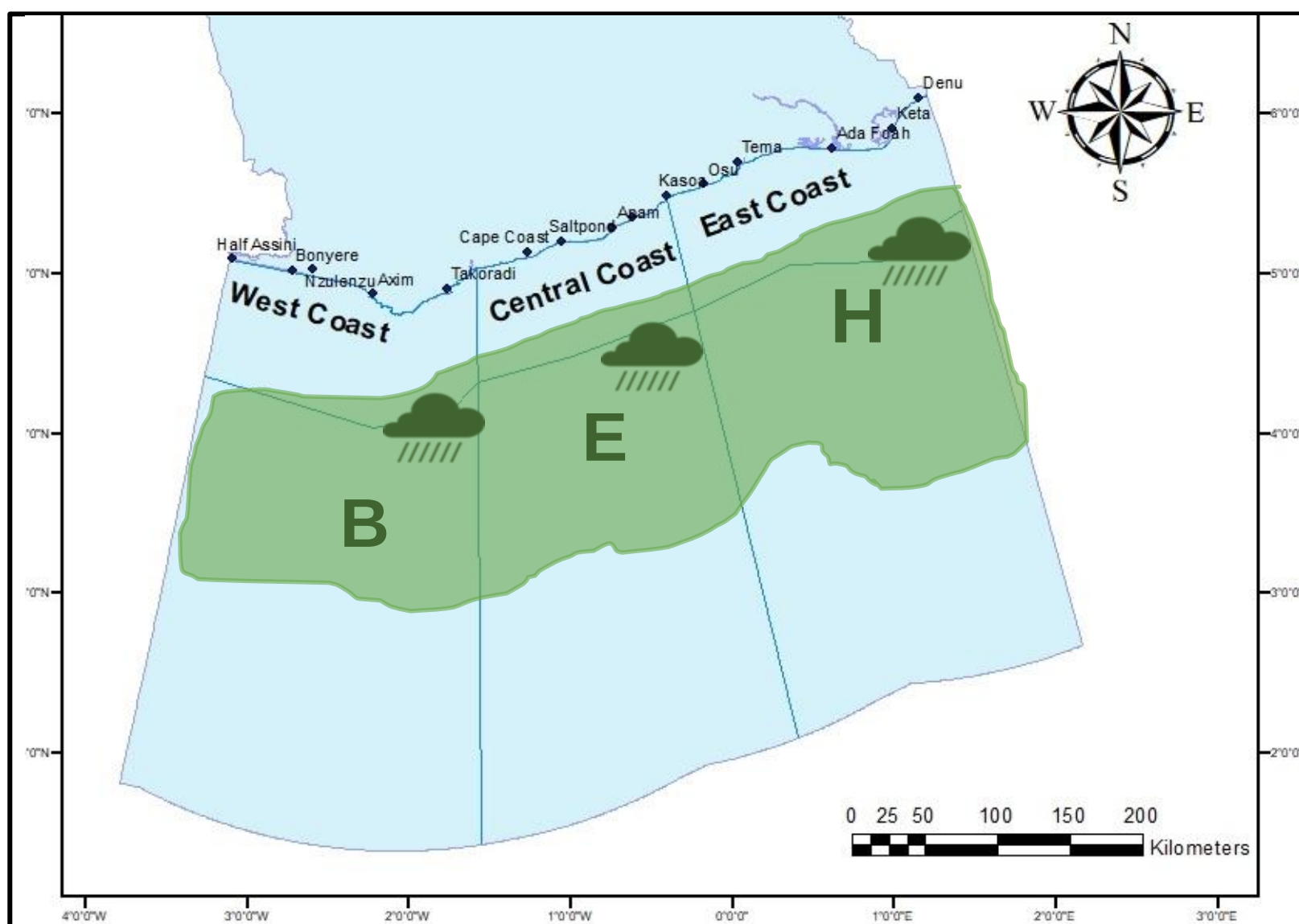

WEATHER SUMMARY: Variably cloudy conditions are expected to persist over the marine zone of Ghana throughout the forecast period. There is a 20% chance of isolated rain and thunderstorms along the coastline in the late afternoon, and a 40% chance of scattered showers and thunderstorms offshore during the early afternoon, with varying intensities. **NOTE: The state of the sea is forecast to be very rough, accompanied by strong winds. Mariners and coastal activities should exercise caution.**
