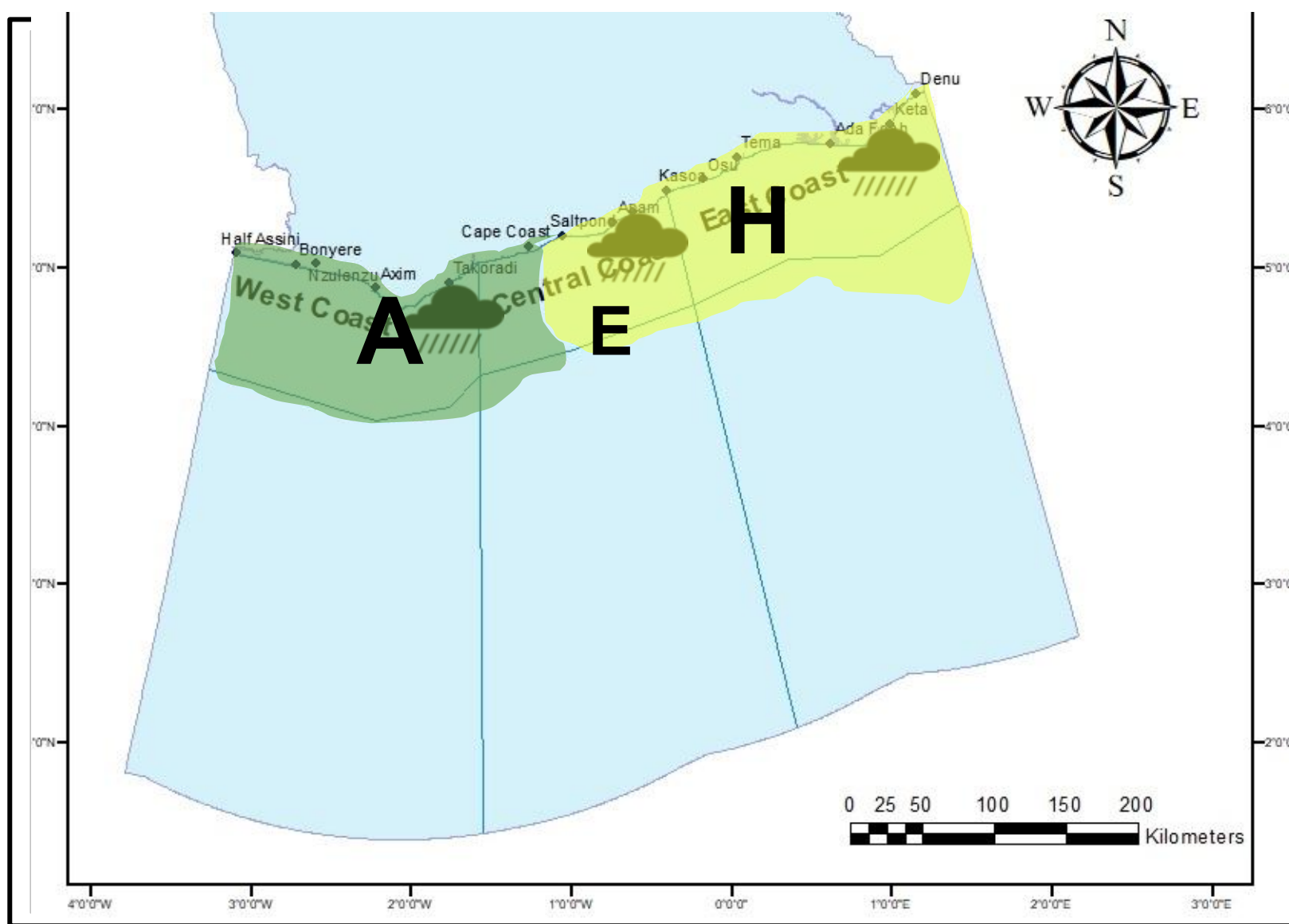

WEATHER SUMMARY: Cloud development is expected tonight through late morning, with a moderate to high chance (40–70%) of scattered to isolated rain showers gradually spreading from the east to the west. Rainfall intensities will vary across locations. Occasional thunderstorms and strong winds are highly likely to occur before and during the rainfall periods. Sea states are forecast to remain rough, and marine users are advised to take necessary precautions.
