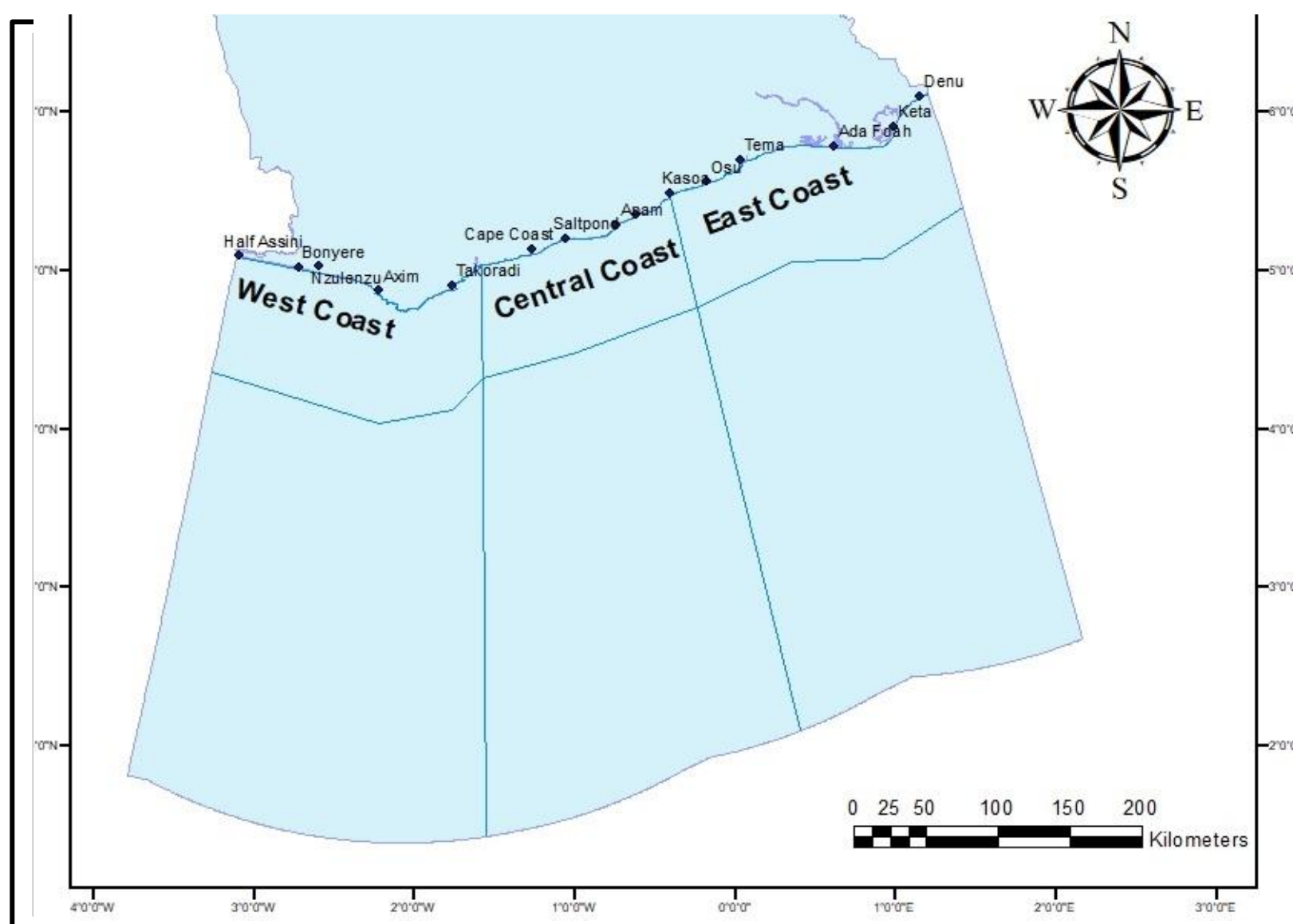

WEATHER SUMMARY: Rain-bearing clouds are expected to develop at the start of the forecast period. There is a 30% chance of these clouds producing isolated to scattered rain showers between late evening and midnight, particularly along the eastern coastal shore. The sea is expected to become very rough tomorrow offshore, posing potential hazards to small vessels and marine operations. Mariners and coastal users are advised to exercise caution.
