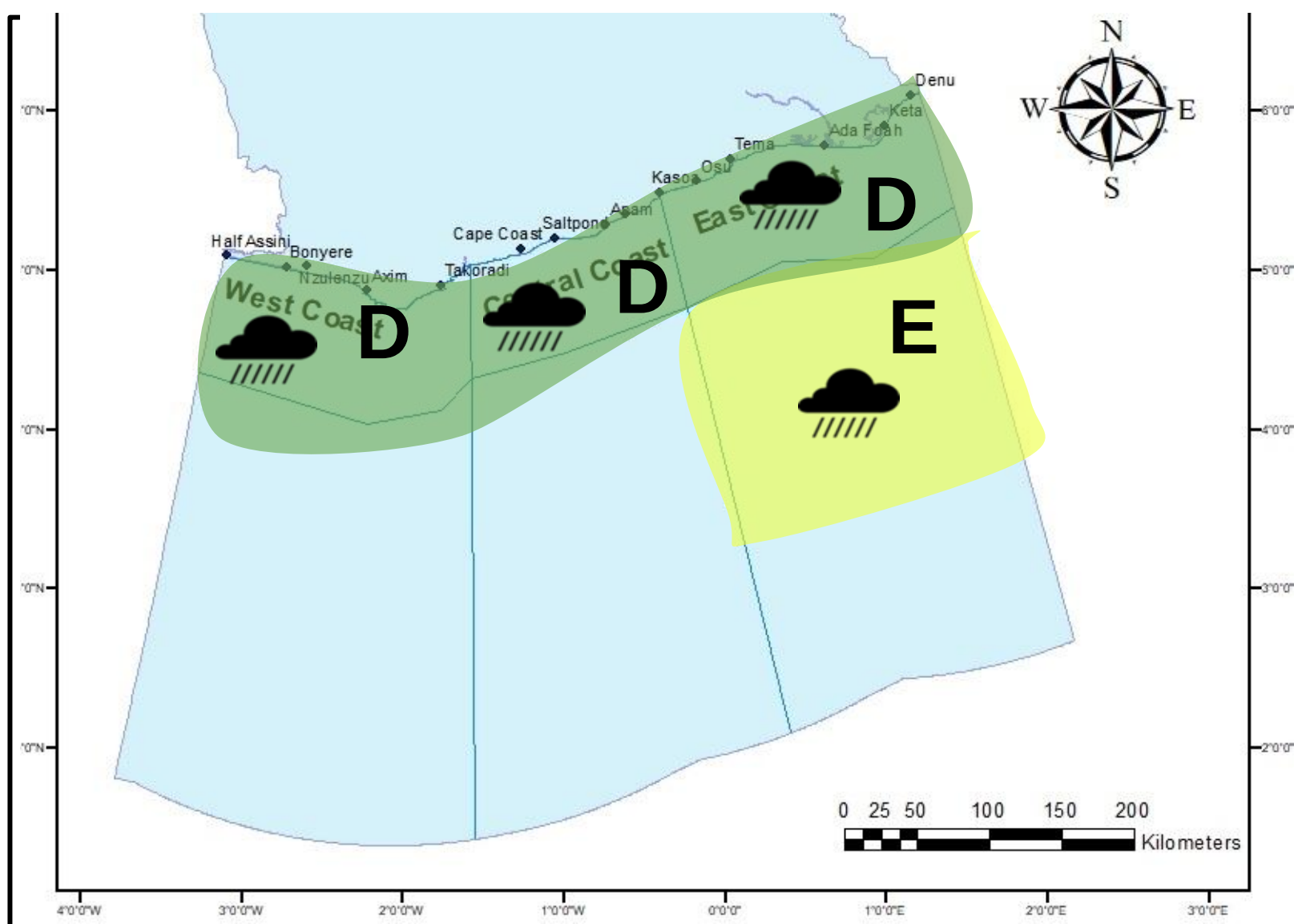

WEATHER SUMMARY: The marine space will experience cloudy conditions with sunny intervals. A 60% likelihood of rain is expected, with thunderstorms likely in the afternoon along the west coastline and central onshore areas by evening. As the day progresses, the entire East Coast is also expected to experience rain of varying intensities.
