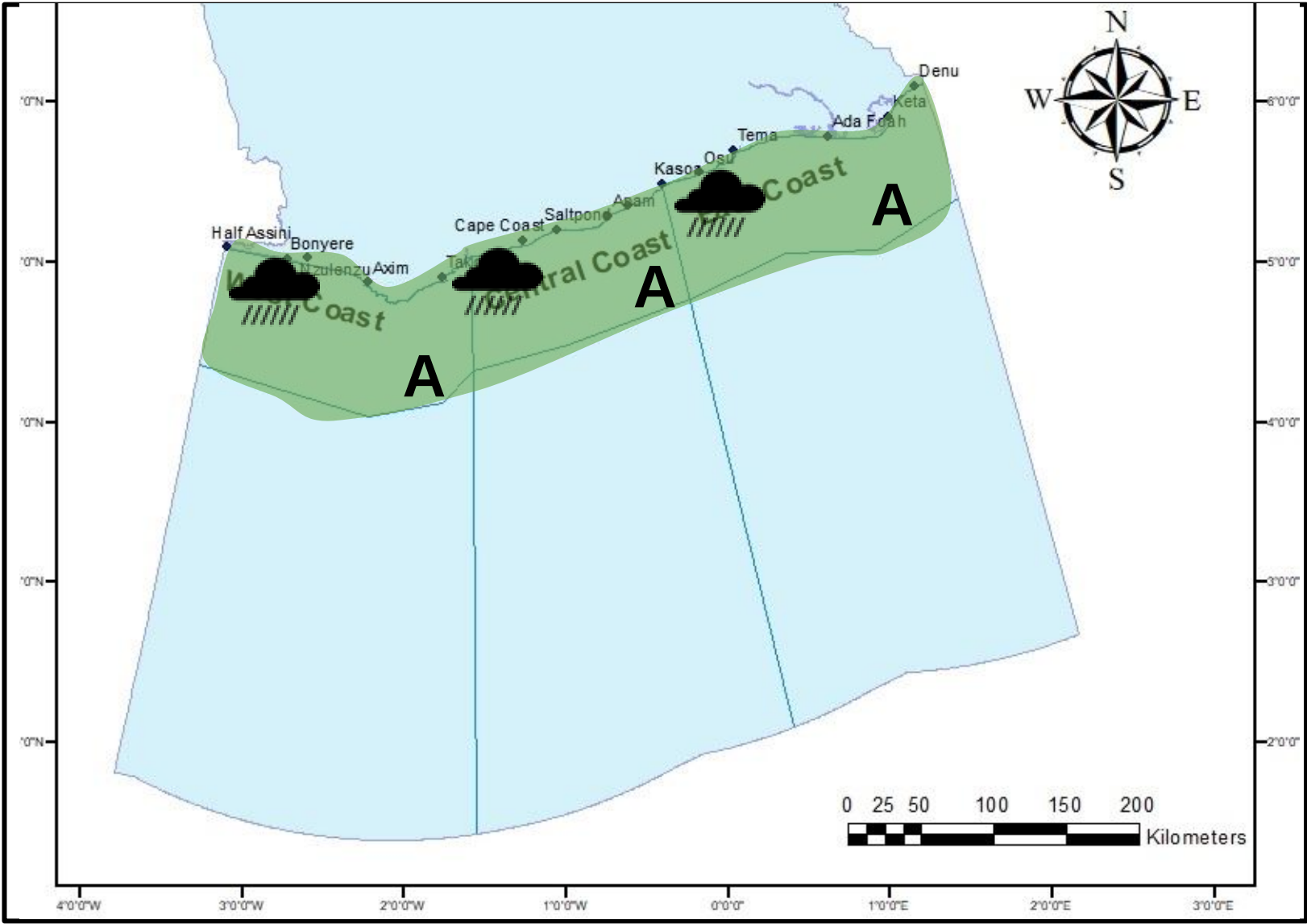

WEATHER SUMMARY: Highly humid conditions are expected across the marine area throughout the forecast period. During the morning hours, fog is likely to form along the coastline, potentially reducing visibility. By late afternoon, there is a 30% chance of isolated showers or thunderstorms developing along coastal areas.
