WEATHER: Fair weather is expected across the country's marine areas this afternoon. As evening approaches, there is a 20% chance of isolated showers along the west coast and eastern offshore regions. Other areas will experience partly cloudy skies. Later in the evening, offshore areas will remain partly cloudy, while partly cloudy conditions gradually move onshore.

NB: The state of the sea is expected to be dangerous throughout the validity period.
