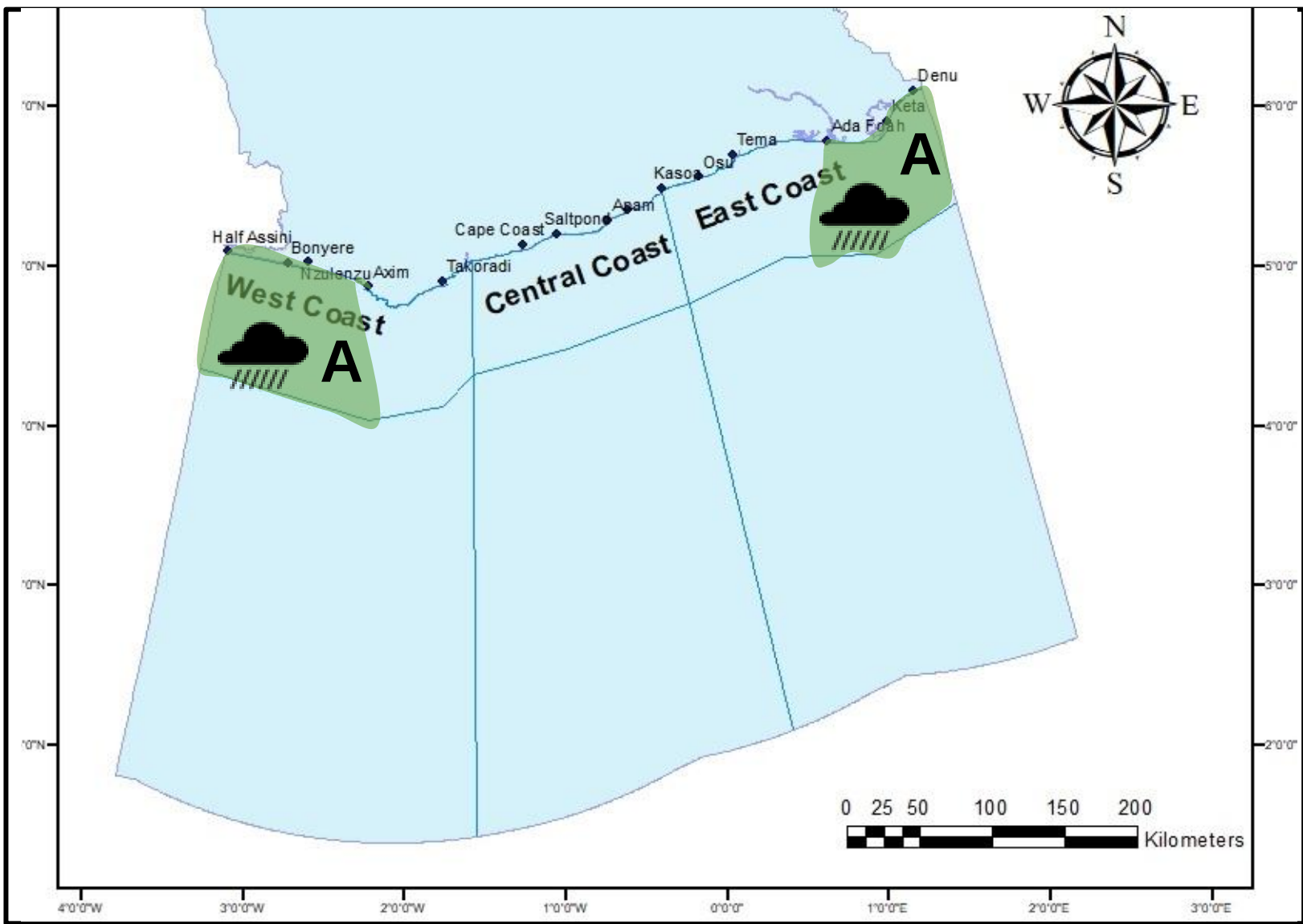

WEATHER SUMMARY: Mostly cloudy conditions are expected to prevail over Ghana's marine areas throughout the forecast period. During the early morning hours, fog is likely to develop along the coastline, reducing visibility. As the morning progresses, there is a 20% chance of light, isolated showers occurring over parts of the eastern and western coastline.
