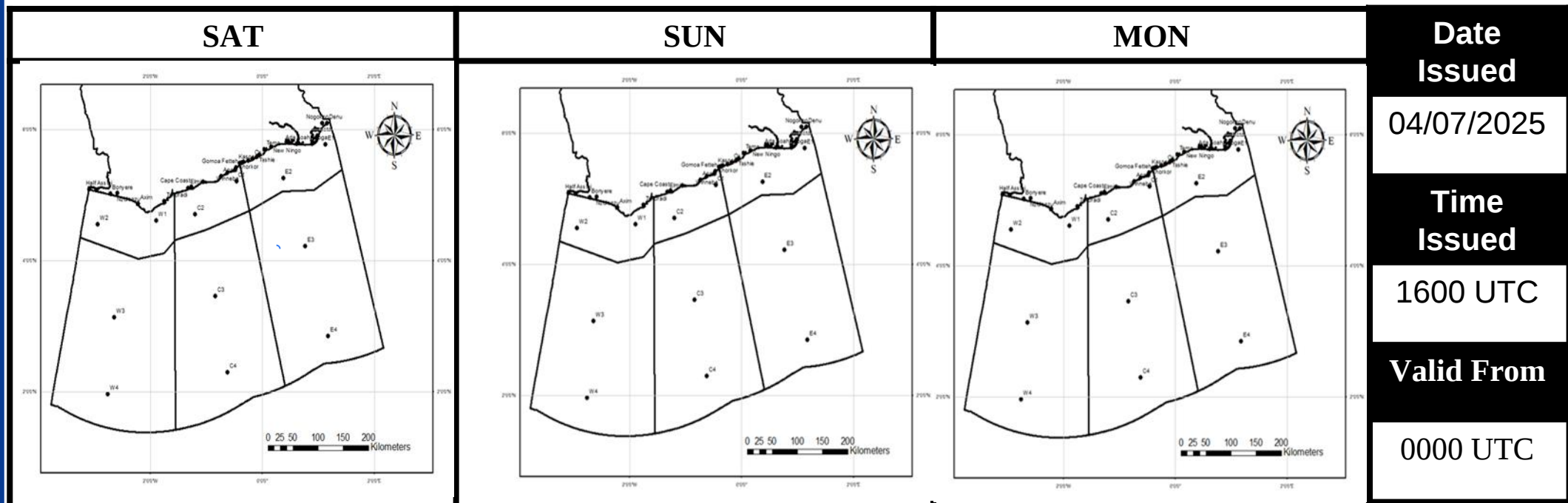

WEATHER SUMMARY

The marine space is expected to be variably cloudy over the weekend, with a (20 – 30)% chance of isolated, intermittent rain likely along the west and east coastlines on both Saturday and Sunday. Offshore areas may also experience similar conditions on Monday.
