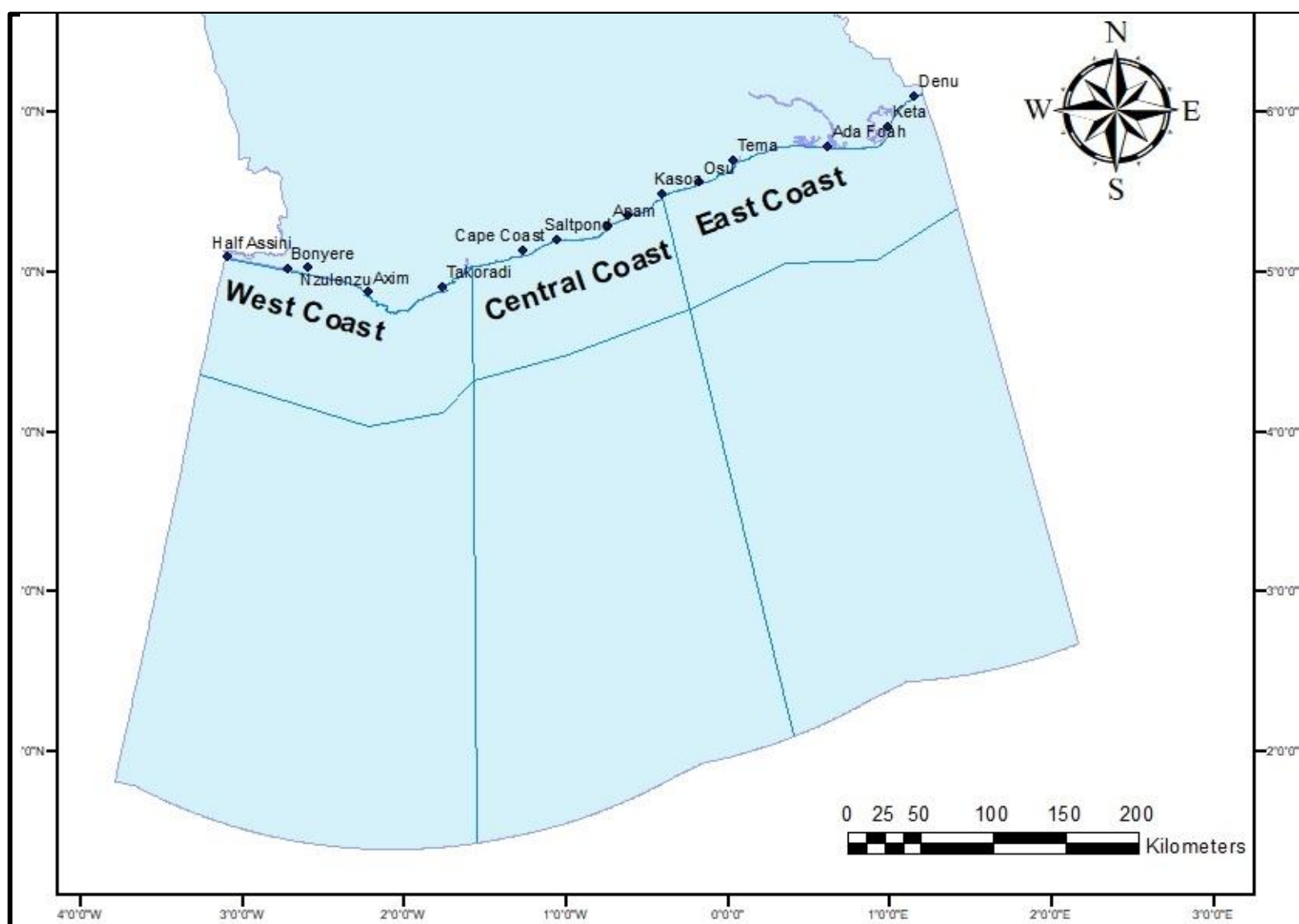

WEATHER SUMMARY: From the afternoon until the end of the forecast period, the east and west coasts are expected to experience variably cloudy conditions, while the central coast will have sunny intervals during the afternoon. However, in the evening through to midnight, the east offshore area has a 60% chance of intermittent rain, whereas the central coast will be mostly cloudy.
