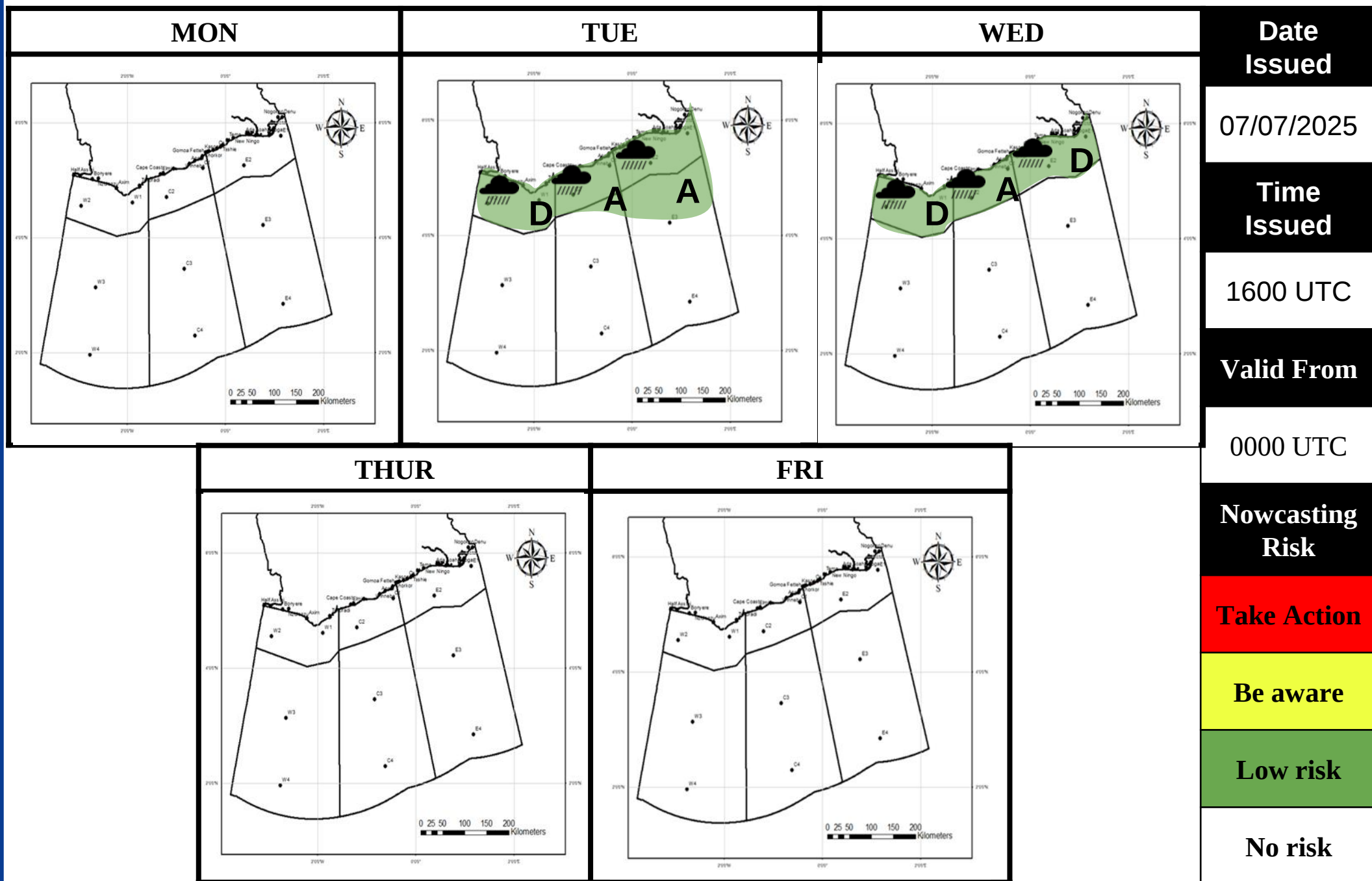

WEATHER SUMMARY

The cloudy weather condition across the country's marine space is expected to persist through to midweek, with chances of intermittent rain of different intensities over some areas offshore and onshore. Varying degree of cloud cover will be experienced on Thursday and Friday, with occasional sunshine along the coastline and areas offshore. Moderate breeze is anticipated over the maritime area during the week. The state of the sea is expected to be rough throughout the forecast period.
