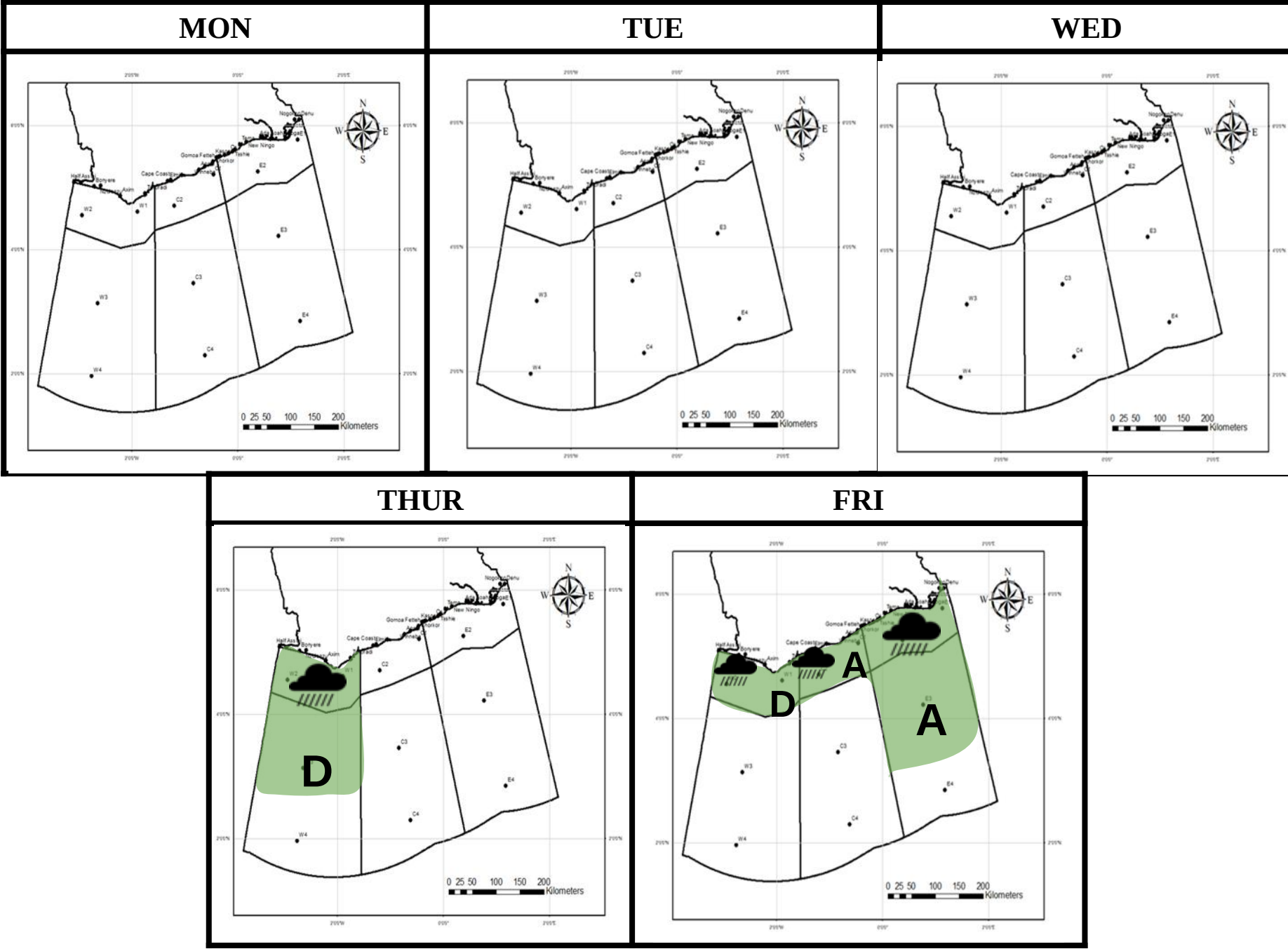

WEATHER SUMMARY

Variably cloudy weather conditions are anticipated over the entire marine space throughout the forecast period. However, periods of sunshine will be expected on Tuesday and Wednesday. On Thursday And Friday, there is a (30 - 40)% chance of slight rains over some areas onshore and offshore. The state of the sea is expected to remain rough throughout the forecast period.
