



WEATHER SUMMARY: Ghana's maritime space is anticipated to remain variably cloudy throughout the forecast period, with occasional sunny intervals expected during the afternoon. Cloud development is likely to result in intermittent rainfall of varying intensities over parts of the coastline from late afternoon into the midnight hours.

NB: The state of the sea is expected to remain rough, and caution is advised.
