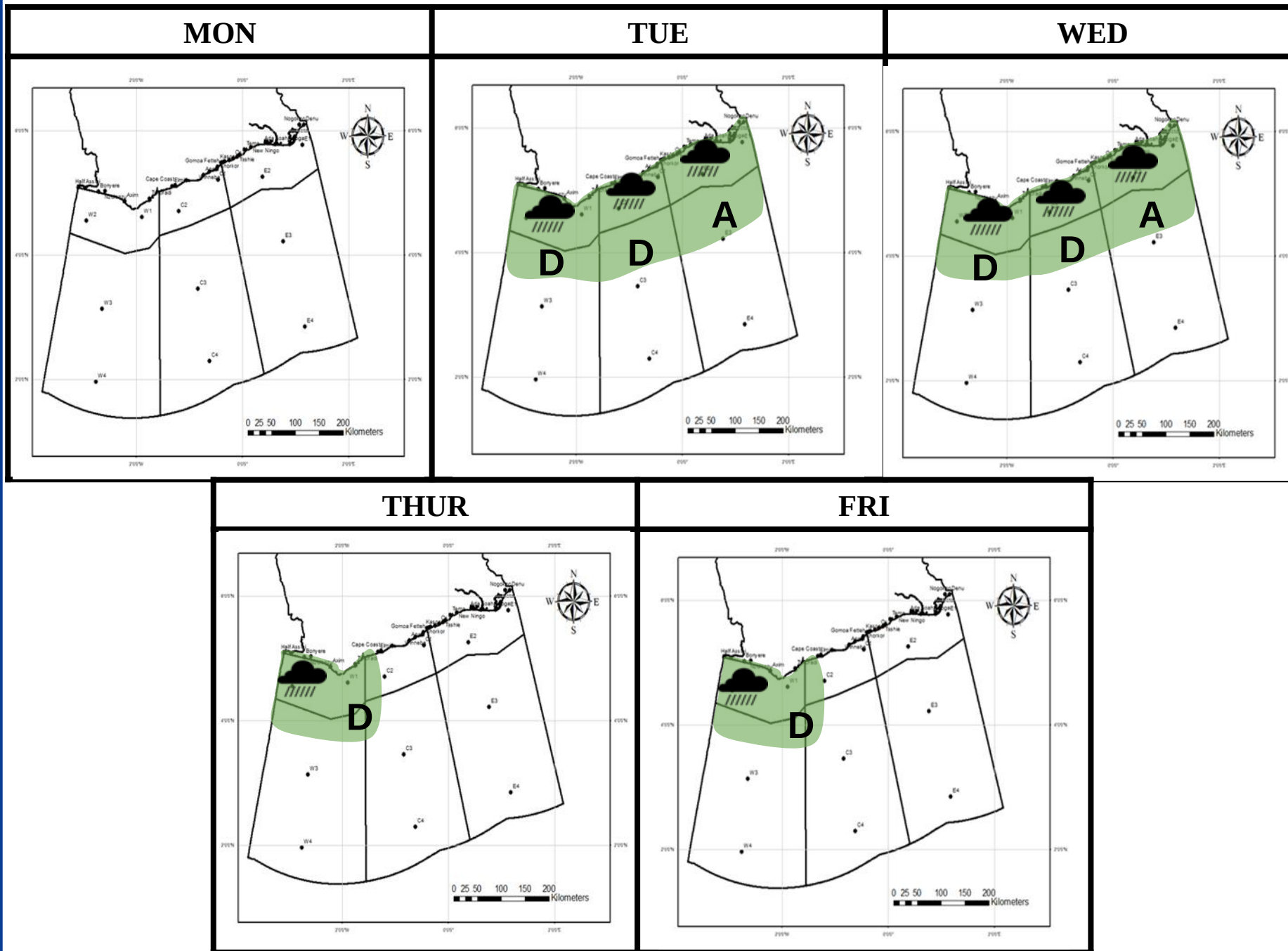




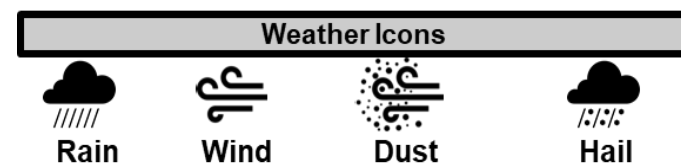

WEATHER SUMMARY

The maritime region of Ghana is expected to be mostly cloudy throughout this week, with occasional sunshine on Thursday and Friday. However, Tuesday and Wednesday, have a (30 - 40)% likelihood of light to moderate rain over some areas onshore and offshore. The state of the sea is expected to remain rough throughout the forecast validity period.
