



WEATHER SUMMARY: This afternoon, the coastline is expected to be mostly sunny with occasional clouds, while offshore areas will remain partly cloudy. By evening, there is a 40–60% chance of moderate rainfall in parts of the coastline and light rain in western offshore regions.

NB: The state of the sea is expected to remain rough this afternoon through to the end of the forecast validity period.
