

WEATHER SUMMARY

Throughout the week, the nation's maritime environment is predicted to be primarily overcast with isolated sunny spells. Nonetheless, there is a (30–60%) chance of slight rain over the onshore regions and intermittent showers over certain offshore regions. Additionally, it is anticipated that the sea condition will continue to be rough, but it is expected to be dangerous from Thursday through Sunday.

NB: The sea state is expected to be dangerous and accompanied by strong winds from Thursday till Sunday. Mariners and coastal activities should exercise caution.
