



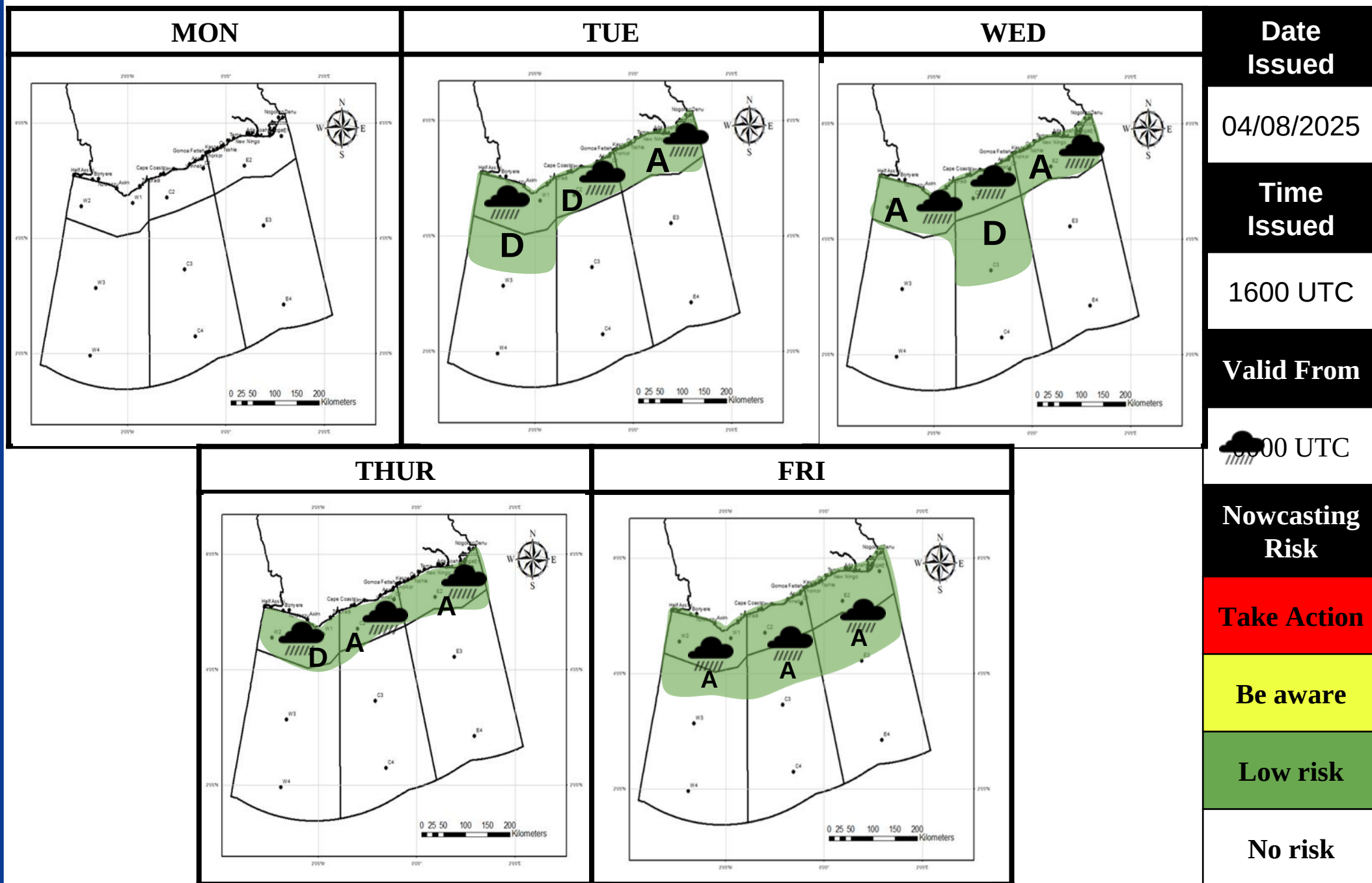

WEATHER SUMMARY

Throughout the week, the nation's maritime environment is predicted to be primarily overcast with isolated sunny spells. Nonetheless, there is a (30–60%) chance of slight rain over the onshore regions and intermittent showers over certain offshore regions. Additionally, it is anticipated that the sea condition will continue to be rough, **but it is expected to be dangerous from Thursday through Sunday.**

NB: The sea state is expected to be dangerous and accompanied by strong winds from Thursday till Sunday. Mariners and coastal activities should exercise caution.
