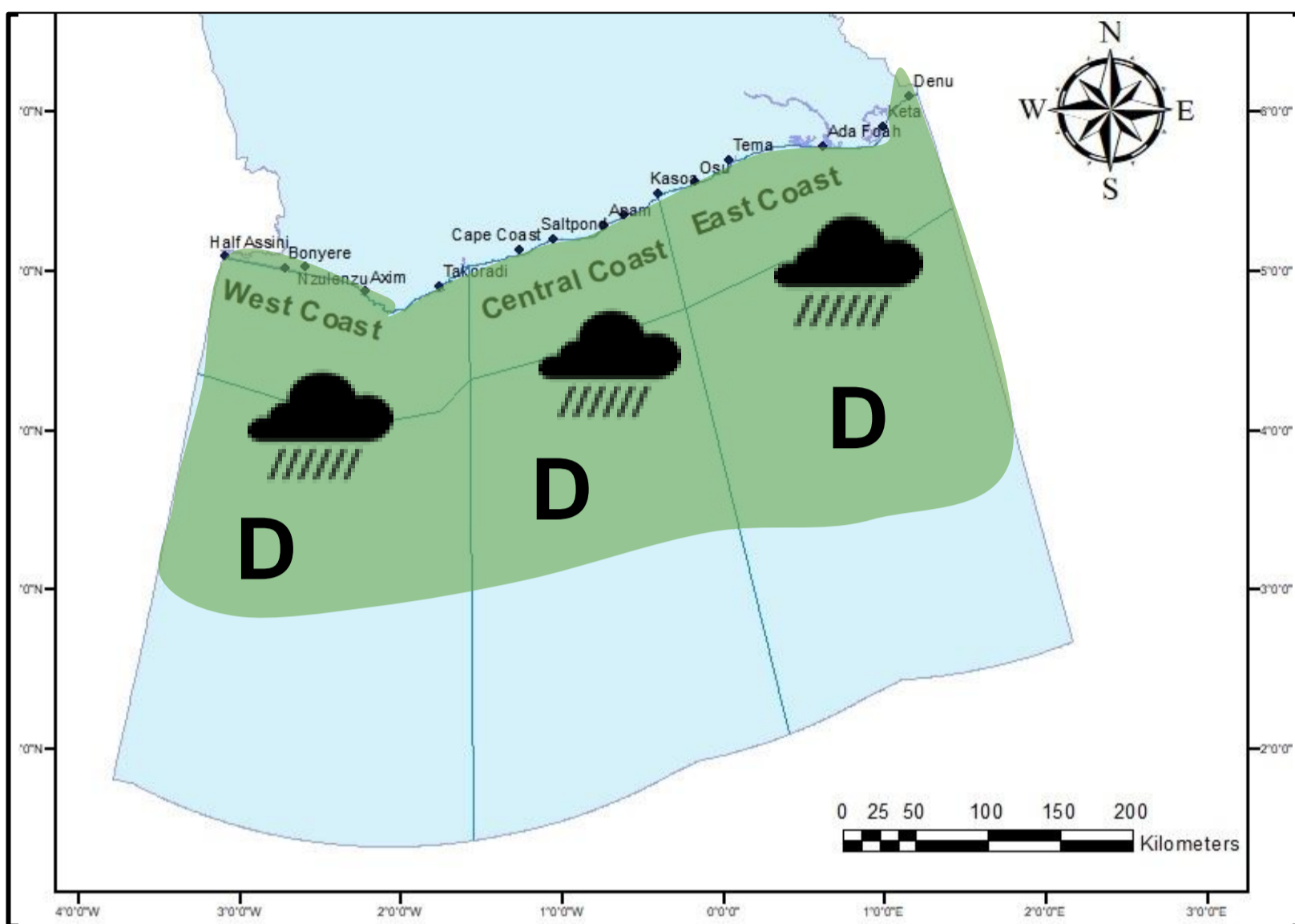

**WEATHER SUMMARY:** Throughout the projected period, the country's marine space is expected to see primarily cloudy weather conditions. However, there is a 40–60% probability of mild to moderate intermittent rainfall over the coastal and offshore areas from this afternoon into the evening.
