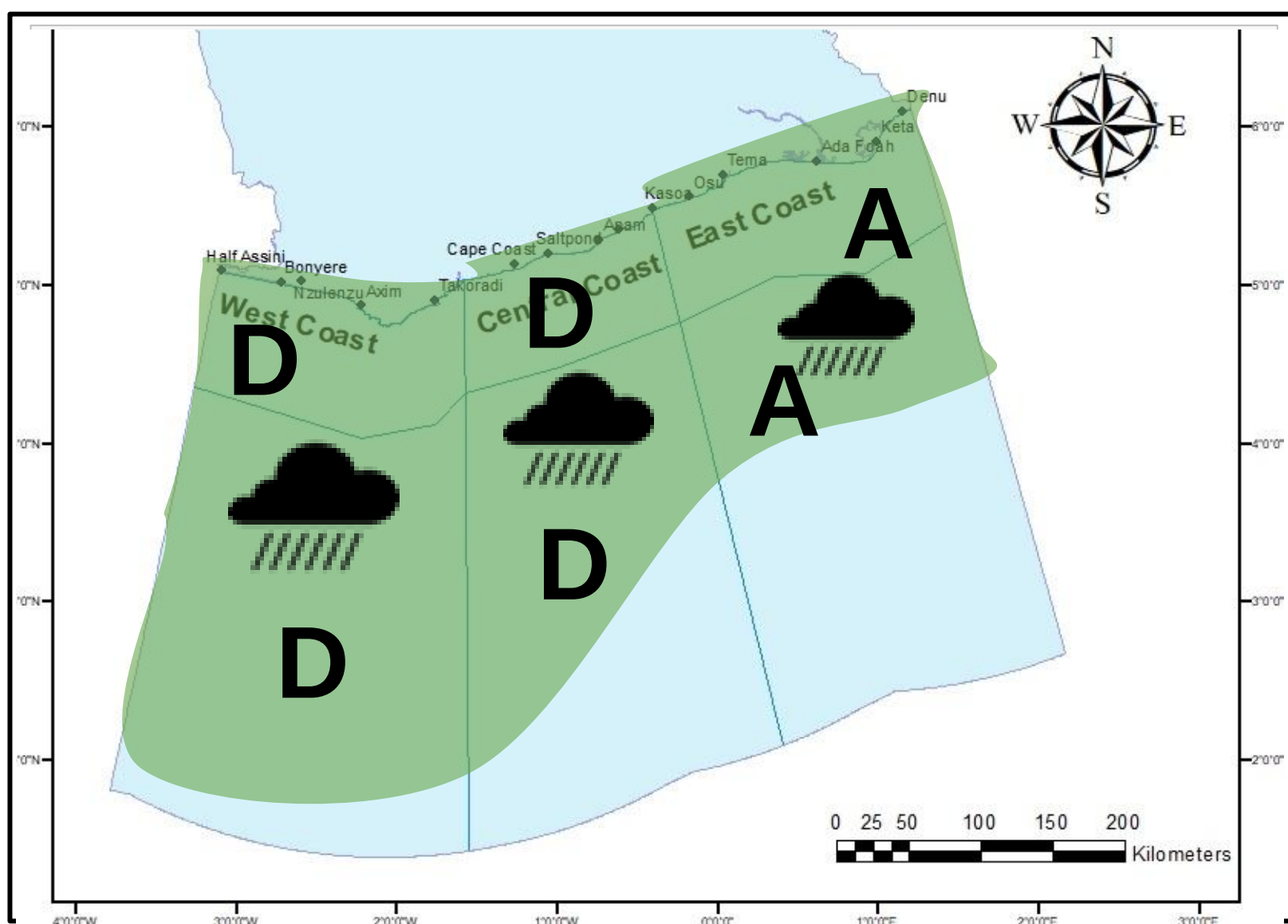

WEATHER SUMMARY: From the start of the forecast period, the country's marine space is expected to be mostly cloudy. There is a 40-60 % chance of scattered light to moderate showers, which would be short-lived over the coastline and some areas offshore. The evening is expected to be mostly cloudy.
