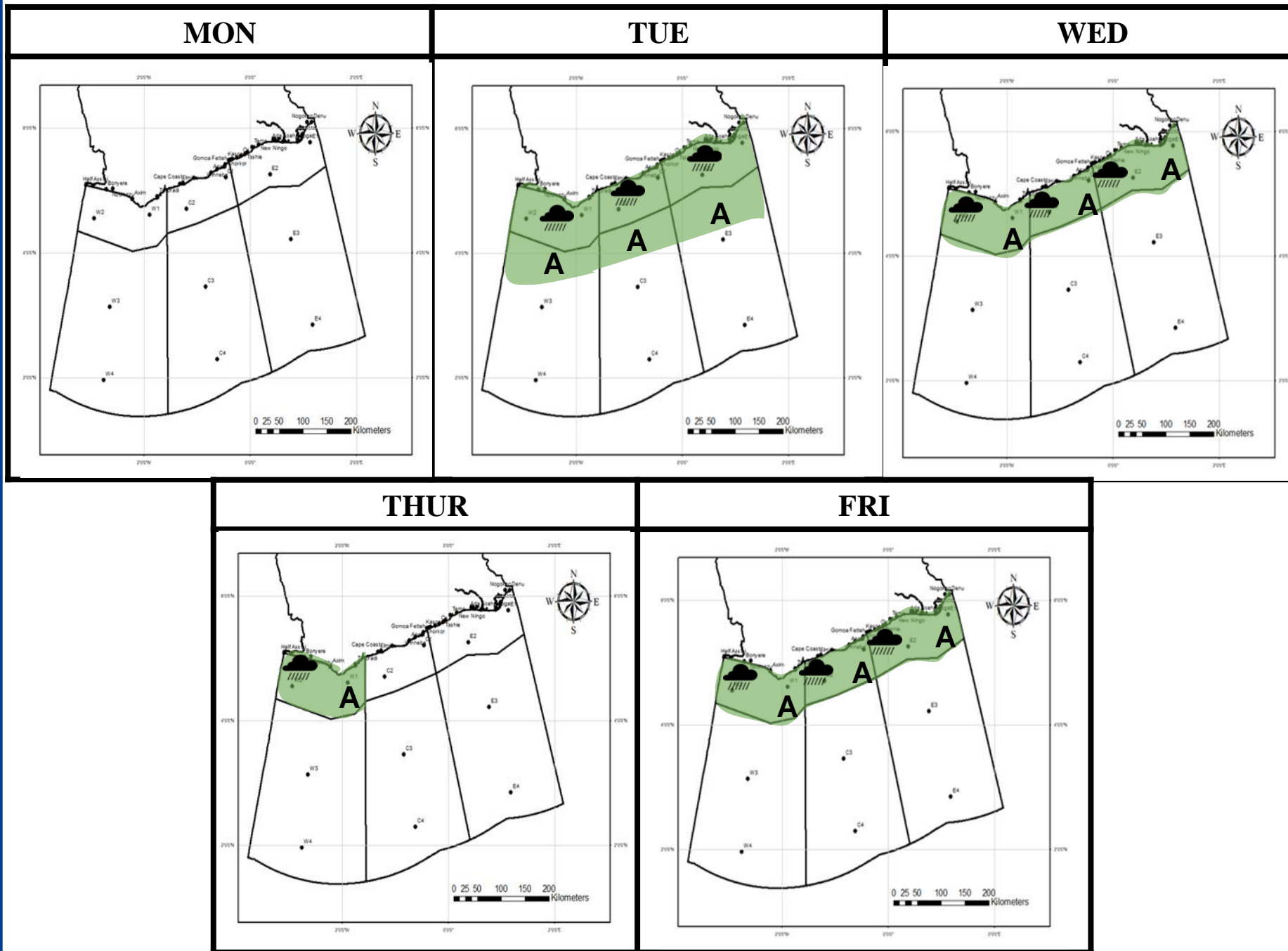

### WEATHER SUMMARY
