

SUMMARY: Partly cloudy conditions with chances of slight rain is anticipated to dominate most places in the southern half of Ghana this evening. Parts of the northern half of the country are expected to be affected by thunderstorms or rain this evening into the night. Mist and fog patches are expected form over the coastal, forest and hilly areas of southern Ghana thereby reducing visibility over these areas.

NB: Cold temperatures will be experienced across the country during the night and early morning hours.
