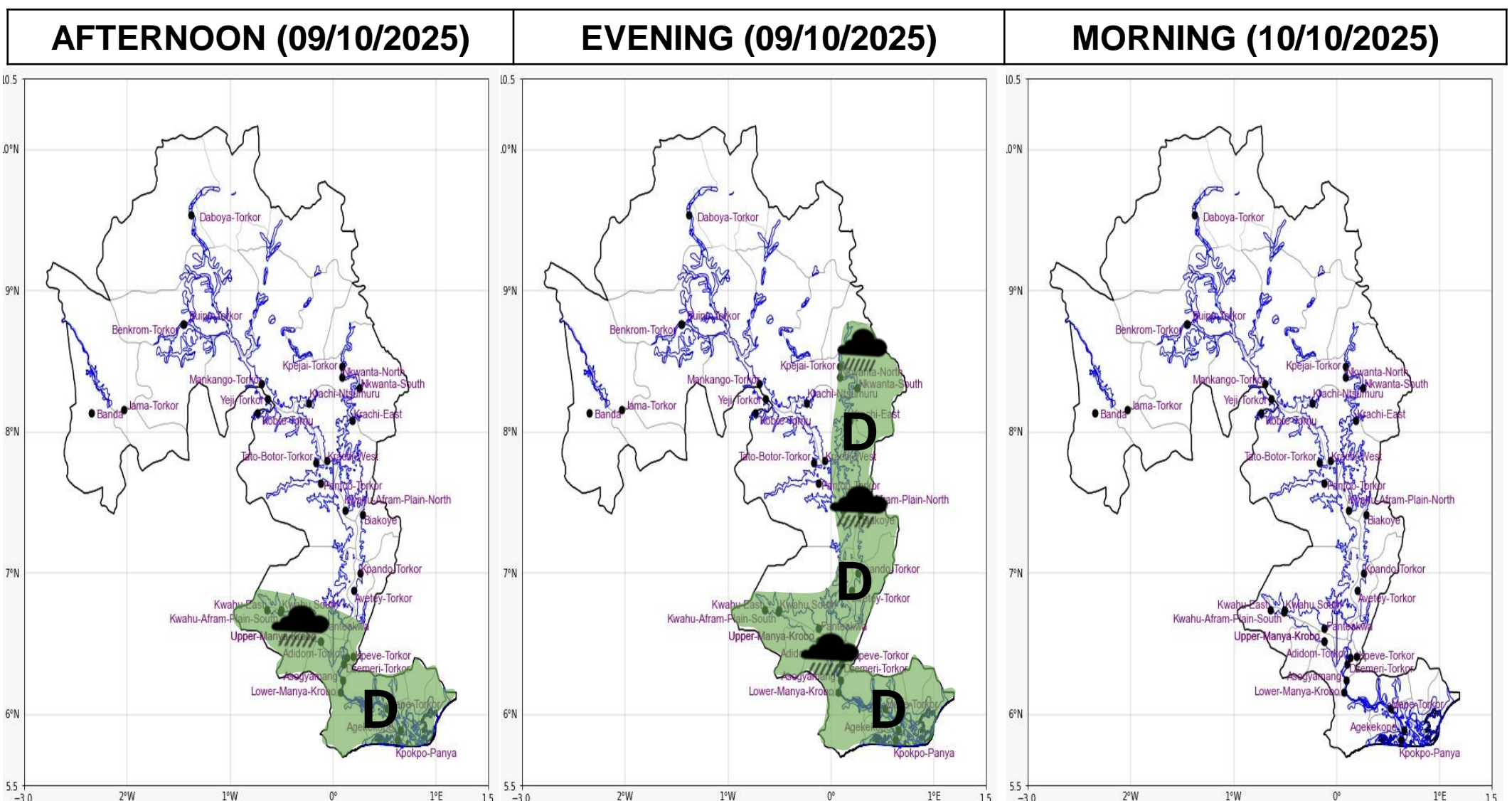




INLAND WATER IMPACT-BASED FORECAST WEATHER SUMMARY

The lake area is anticipated to experience breaks of sunshine during the afternoon hours. Mostly cloudy conditions and rain of varying intensities, with possible thunderstorms, are expected over the southern portion of the lake and later extend to the eastern portion of the lake and its vicinity in the evening.
