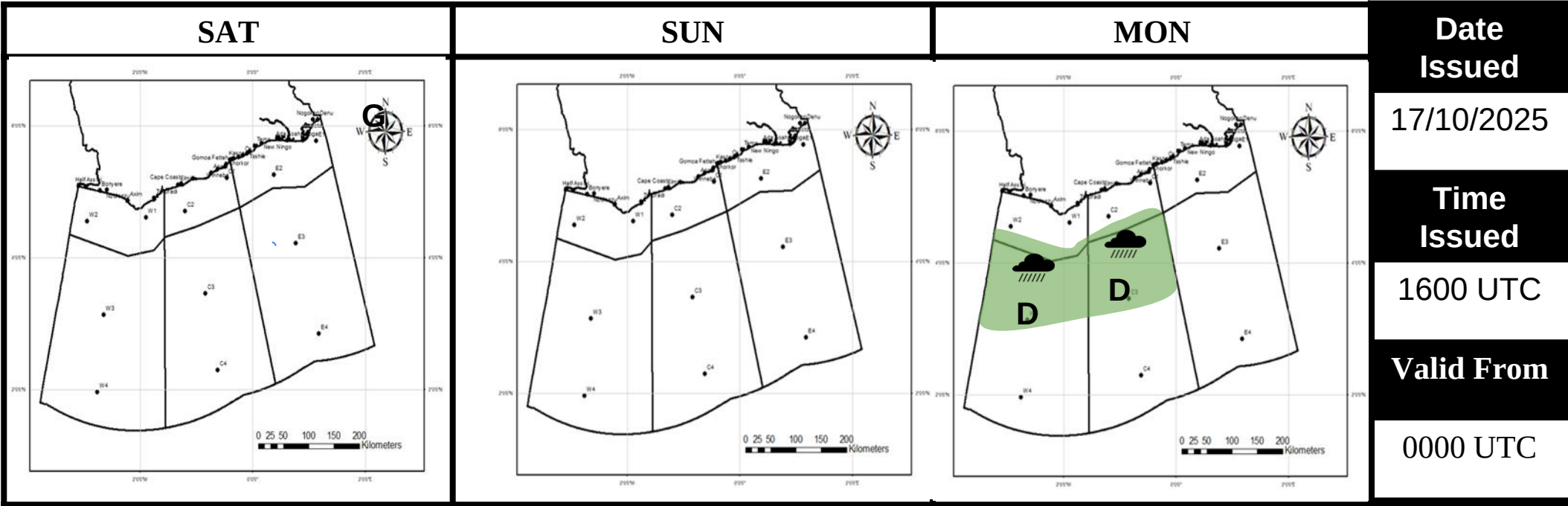

WEATHER SUMMARY

The marine space of Ghana will experience variable cloud cover throughout the forecast period with sunny spells during the afternoon hours. However, there is a 40% chance of intermittent rain across the offshore of the west and central coasts between afternoon and evening hours on Monday. The state of the sea remains rough throughout the forecast duration except on Monday, which is calm.
